

## Conditions of Entry

1. To be run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2019 – which can be downloaded from the Pony Club website [here](#), please read them and don't hesitate to ask if you have any questions.
2. All riding competitors must be correctly dressed as per rules including PC tagged XC hat, Beta 2009/2018 Level 3 Body protector.
3. Age as at 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019
4. Judge's decision is final, competitors must be current Pony Club non riding or riding members.
5. Shooting: Please remain silent outside the shooting hall, to enable safety instructions to be heard. **In accordance with the law on Air Pistols: No person under the age of 18 is allowed to carry a gun, or pellets anyone found doing so will be eliminated from the competition.** Guns must not be unboxed until authorised by the steward. Guns must be kept hidden and locked in your car boot after shooting, please do not leave in shooting hall.
6. Swimming: Only 1 Team Coach per swimmer allowed at the shallow end and please sit / stand back from the pool edge to enable the lane judges to walk back and forwards to judge the swims accurately and safely.
7. Photography: **No photography in the swimming pool or adjacent area please.** Otherwise, entry is deemed agreement that photographs may be taken.
8. Ride penalties will be in briefing and at arena course – clear is 1400 max score.  
No stopwatches or shouted timing instructions during ride phase.  
Knockdown = 30 penalties, First Refusal = 60 penalties, Second Refusal = 100 penalties  
Two refusals – carry on to next fence (if a competitor does not, they must retire)  
Refusal + knockdown = 80 penalties Rider Fall = 90 penalties, 2 Rider falls = retirement  
Fall of horse = retirement Each fence not jumped after retirement = 50 penalties  
Error of Course not rectified = retirement  
Speed: **325 mpm plus** 15 seconds each for gate or slip rail if included  
Each commenced second over the time allowed = 4 penalties 75 Secs over the time allowed = retirement

**Legal Liability** Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

**Health and Safety** The organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards.

## Teams, Prizes and Rosettes:

- Prizes for best shoot, swim and run in each class.
- Team rosettes to 4<sup>th</sup> place in each tri class, where numbers allow.

Teams will consist of 4 members, best 3 scores to count. We will put individuals into teams, if not entered in Branch Teams.

## XC Heights / information by Class – Arena Riding Phase – inc Gate & Slip Rail

Open – up to 1m SJ and simulated XC, whole course timed vs optimum time  
Junior – up to 90cm SJ and simulated XC, whole course timed vs optimum time  
Mini – up to 80cm SJ and simulated XC, course not timed for tet score  
Tadpole – up to 60 cm SJ and simulated XC, course not timed for tet score  
Beanies – up to 40cm SJ and simulated XC, course not timed for tet score

Competitors **may ask in advance** to jump 1 class smaller – penalty 500 points  
Competitors in Beanies / Tadpoles may be led – penalty 700 points  
Competitors in Beanies / Tadpoles may be accompanied – penalty 500 points
