The Caroline Cup is an annual competition where we compete in teams.

The Teeny Weeny Grassroots Competition consists of Turnout, Dressage, and a Handy Pony Round. The Combined Training consists of a Dressage round and a Showjumping Round where each team member does a different test and jump height. If you ride as an Individual you ride a Dressage Test and your chosen SJ height.

EFFICIENCY TESTS

As our members progress within Pony Club and develop their Pony Care and Riding knowledge they have the opportunity to do Efficiency Tests. These tests start with the E Test from 4 years old and progress right through until the A Test which they can take when they are at least 17.

The purpose of the tests is to ensure that members have an all round knowledge about how to care for their horses and ponies. They learn all about the different facets relating to their horses and ponies from the colours of horses; the points of the horse; everything there is no know about their tack and how to use it properly; how to make the right choices about their ponies' welfare, stabling, food. Completing efficiency tests is highly recommended when you are in Pony Club and it can also lead to lots of other fun within the Club including being part of the Quiz Teams.

We have just recently run our annual Efficiency Test Day and lots of members have taken part and worked very hard to pass their tests.

WINTER STABLE MANAGEMENT

Stable Management is where we incorporate the unmounted learning into Pony Club life. It is where the members learn about Pony Care and develop the knowledge that they can use to pass efficiency tests and to join Quizzing teams.

Stable Management is also where members can hang out and have fun with their pony club pals and not worry about ponies while they're learning. It is great fun and they have the added bonus of earning lots of badges for their PC sweatshirts.

We'll be running Stable Management a little differently this winter. We'll run SM sessions alongside our other winter training, as follows:

- Flatwork Training stable management will be about Tack. Members will learn all things related to Tack and the various kit you would use for your ponies;
- Jump Training stable management will be about Feeding. Members will learn about feeding & fitness and related topics; and
- Games Practice stable management will be about General Pony Knowledge, this will include topics like Points of the Horse; Colours and more.

You'll be able to book into Stable Management in conjunction with the training on that particular day or just the Stable Management class in that training event on Entry Master. We look forward to seeing our members learning lots this winter.













The Pony Club Guidelines on the Use Of Spurs

Members wishing to ride with spurs at Pony Club activities must have achieved the C+ Riding Test or The Spurs Test, both of which are Area level tests.

It is important that spurs are only worn by riders who have a stable lower leg and who are able to use – or not use – the spur intentionally.
