


EAST ABERDEENSHIRE ARENA EVENT



Please remember that with the joy of riding at the field comes some responsibility:

- Please ensure you arrive early enough for your rallies and lessons to help instructors get set up and please always be willing to help pack away at the end of the day.
- Don't forget we pack away all jumps, back onto trailers, at the end of every session. Please return jumps cups to the bins provided.
- Please ensure that you park as required. The field has some soft, wet spots and early in the season these can be sink spots for trucks and trailers. If you are not sure where to park please ask one of the more long standing members and they will be happy to help;
- Due to an incident in the past we ask that <u>ALL</u> ponies are put back in their boxes when they are not being ridden this is a strictly enforced rule within our club;
- Please remember hats must be worn by members and visitors under the age of 16 at all times when ponies are out of trailers and if ponies are being handled in trailers;
- Please always bring your own water and water bucket to the field;
- Please take all poo; fallen hay & litter home with you;
- Please keep the gate closed at all times;

Riding on the field in the summer is such a special time. We look forward to seeing you all there and to having another Summer of Pony Loving Fun.
