Excellent work Harry!



The Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival is a competition series for Dressage, Show Jumping and Arena Eventing. Riders compete to qualify for the Final. There are levels for every competitive member depending on eligibility:

- Arena Eventing 70cm, 80cm, 90cm, 100cm and 110cm
- Dressage Preliminary PC70, Grassroots PC80, Novice, Intermediate and Open
- Show Jumping PC70, 80cm, 90cm, 100cm and 110cm

All members will need to qualify through preliminary rounds to get to the final.
