



Age Group



- Strictly no extendable leads
- No Vaping/smoking near lessons


Member and Pony Health and Safety

- Tagged hats must be worn by all members and safety hats by siblings if there are horses out of boxes/trailers
- Ponies must be in boxes when not being handled


Our First Aid Cover by Age Group as at end Dec 2025




- Parent cover for each lesson
