RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY. NOTES FOR TEAM MANAGERS.

- This competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Dressage Rules 2017. Please read the rules which can be downloaded from the Pony Club website before entering.
- Eligibility of horse/pony and all tack and dress must comply with the 2017 Rule Book. No rider will be allowed to enter the warm up area until their tack check has been completed. Competitors must present for tack check at least 30 minutes before their dressage time. Pony Club members may wear spurs with the permission of their District Commissioner. Members without the B Test must carry their signed membership card. All B Test members must wear their red felt.
- No rider or horse/pony may compete in more than one class.
- Regionals Championships Qualifier- Riders are not eligible if they have:
 - Previously represented their branch or centre at Novice level or above at any Pony Club Dressage or Eventing Area Competitions.
 - Combination of Horse and Rider are NOT eligible if they have competed at above Prelim level in British Dressage (DI)
- Only horses that are competing are allowed on site.
- A fastened hat must be worn at all times when mounted. All hats must be tagged with either a WHITE Pony Club or RED British Eventing tag. Please refer to the Pony Club website – http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/dcs/Hat_Rule_2016_FV.pdf Hats can be tagged at the Secretary's Tent at the cost of £3.
- Objections must be made in writing, together with a £25 deposit and addressed to the Organisers or Secretary within 30 minutes after scores have been published. See rule 50.
- Prize giving will be dismantled in front of the Secretary's tent.
- No mucking out in the parking field and please take your litter home with you.
- No horse/pony to be tied to any trailer/lorry and left unattended.
- If cancelled for any reason, £5 will be retained from the entry fee to cover advanced costs.
- No Lungeing or exercising in the lorry park. There will be a roped off designated lungeing area.
- Any competitor who has a fall or sustains a serious injury anywhere at the competition site must see medical personnel on the day and be passed fit to ride before riding ANY horse.
- Any rider having a fall injury needs to report to the Secretary to have the fall logged in the Accident Log.
- Bad language and or abuse of any horse, rider or official will not be tolerated and may result in elimination.
- Dogs will be allowed on the show site. Please keep them on a lead and under control.
