This strategy has seen us starting to dominate the scoreboards in most disciplines which is a tremendous legacy.

#### Tests & Training

Pony Club is first and foremost a training organisation. The test structure starts with E Test at a minimum age of 4 and works up to A Test which member can take up to the age of 25. The Pony Club training structure encourages members to take tests which enables them to learn progressively about horse and pony care and riding.

\*\* The next E Test will be on March 23rd.

We are currently working on a programme for training and tests in 2025 for C/C+ & D/D+, the dates will be announced very soon.

**B Test** training has started and is ongoing.
