All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee which will be stated online on a per class basis.

Entries for all classes will only be accepted from the official branch email address e.g. branch@pcuk.org or from one appointed team manager email address.

NO entries from individual members will be accepted.

Combination of horse and rider can compete at two adjacent levels apart from the Grassroots and Novice.

Changes to Entries: For **ALL** changes of horse and rider substitutions **before or after the closing date** please email entriesblankney@gmail.com

Withdrawals: Full refund up to the closing date; no refunds after the closing date.

Abandonment: In the event of the competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given. In such an instance the refund policy will be communicated and must be followed.

Teams: Branch Teams must consist of three or four members from the same branch/centre. If a branch has a member/s who are not included in a team, they may combine with one or more branches/centres to form an Area Team. These teams will be put together by Patrick Campbell, Area 6 Rep. Area Teams are eligible to qualify for the Championships, however they do not take a place of a Branch Team: the next placed eligible Branch Team shall also qualify.

Order of Riding: Competitors will be allocated to arenas in the order that they appear on the declaration form.

Times: Will be posted on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk no later than Friday 28th June.

Scores: will be posted on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk Any queries should be raised with the event secretary at the information point.

Prize giving will take place at the end of each class

Individual Rosettes for each section 1st to 8th, prizes to 3rd place in each section;
Team Rosettes for each class 1st to 6th

Competitor's numbers: Competitors must supply their own numbers: number bibs are preferred with a printed number which you must print out at home (for the front and back of bib) from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk where you will find your times. Or competition numbers clearly displayed on either side of the horse (bridle or saddle cloth).

Commanders: Commanders are permitted for the Preliminary PC70 Regional Qualifiers and Grassroots PC80 Regional Qualifiers **ONLY**.

Dressage Tests: Dressage Sheets will be available at the end of the class as soon as all results are in. Please leave a SAE in the box at the Information Point on the day if you would like your dressage test posting to you.

Whips: May be of any length and may be carried during the test.

This competition will be run under the **Pony Club Dressage Rules 2024**

A valid passport including up to date **flu vac** record must be carried. Spot checks will be made at the event.

All hats must be tagged to comply with the Pony Club Hat Rule 2024, with a PINK hat tag. HAT tagging will be available at the information point.

Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside **at any time**.

Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.

Health & Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials, and stewards.
