Arrival:

Please arrive at approximately 9:30am and park in your designated area: this will be signposted.

Unload your pony and be ready for training at 10am.

Please bring with you a full haynet, water bucket, full grooming kit, and muck scoop.

At the end of the day, please clear your area and remove any droppings or loose hay from the parking area.

Ponies will go back to your lorry/trailer at lunch and during non-riding activities. They must not be tied unattended outside the lorry/trailer.

Starting at 10am each day with a rotation of activities including:

- Flatwork
- Show Jumping
- Games
- Horse & Pony Care including badges
- XC training
- Mini Fun Competition
- Tack Cleaning

Activities finish by 3.30pm

Depart by 4pm

Presentation on Sunday at approximately 3pm



What to wear:

- Tagged (PINK) Riding Hat/Jockey Skull
- Body protector (Blue/black label 2018) for XC jumping
- Jodphurs (plain single colour)
- Plain white shirt with collar and Pony Club tie
- Pony Club sweatshirt or navy-blue plain sweatshirt (no hoodies)
- Plain blue or black hat silk
- Plain chaps same colour/material as riding boots
- Gloves
- Long hair must be tied back <u>and in a hairnet</u>
- No jewellery to be worn unless for medical reasons.
- Crosscountry colours may be worn for crosscountry training.



A whip, if carried, must be held in the hand by the handle with the handle at the top.

For SJ/XC The whip must be 'padded'.

Maximum length of the whip is 70cm and must be no less than 45 cm.

For dressage, the whip may be of any length suitable for the size of the pony.



For the pony:

 Tack to be clean, in a good state of repair, properly fitted and suitable for purpose.

Plain numnahs/saddle cloths.

• Stirrups should be of the correct size to suit the rider's boots. They must have 7mm (¼") clearance on either side of the boot. Magnetic stirrups not allowed.

 Humane girths are not permitted. A humane girth is described as having non-independent straps that will loosen if one of the straps was to break.








Achievement badges:
