We are returning to the fantastic Riseholme College, Lincoln for our Senior Camp this year. Facilities include large indoor stabling, indoor and outdoor arenas and plenty of space for all the other activities planned.

Horses will be able to stay over, supervised by experienced adults and a member of Riseholme Equine Team on site. There is no rider accommodation, so riders travel in and out each day.

Provisional daily routine:

8am Arrive for stables and prepare horses.
9am Breakfast.
10am First ridden or unmounted session.
12.30pm Lunch
4pm Stables, tacking cleaning and activities.
6pm Evening meal
7pm approx. Departure for riders

There is no XC this year due to the closure of Hoods.

The cost of camp remains at **£235** which includes all instruction, activities, meals for the riders, stabling and hay/straw for the horses. You will need to provide any hard feed, haylage or shavings that your horse/pony may require.

Senior Camp is an annual highlight for our Pony Club members and with an emphasis on learning, friendship and FUN, we look forward to welcoming you to a busy, fun-filled, Senior Camp 2024!
