

Entry is deemed to be in acceptance of these conditions:

This event will be run under the [Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026](#)

- A valid passport including up to date [flu vac record](#) must be carried. Spot checks may be made at the event,
- **All hats must be tagged to comply with the [Pony Club Hat Rule 2026](#), with a **PINK hat tag. HAT tagging will be available at the information point.****
- [Body Protectors BETA Level 3 2018](#) must be worn for the cross-country phase, and as a minimum, shoulders must be covered when competing. Air jackets if worn for XC, must be over a body protector.
- For Pony Club members, the competitor's hat must bear the **Yellow Hat Tag** to indicate eligibility to wear spurs.
- Commanders for the dressage test are permitted in PC70 and PC80 classes.
- No Whips are allowed in the dressage phase at PC90 and PC100.
- No stop watches are allowed at PC70 and PC80.
- Horses/ponies must be at least 5 years old. No horse/pony may compete more than once. No one other than the competitor may ride the horse/pony at the event.
- Horses/Ponies must not be left unattended outside **at any time.**

Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes.

Health & Safety: Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, officials, and stewards.
