PONY CLUB ONLY

START TIME 9am PROMPT

Class 1 Mini Elf Stakes - tiny fences show jumping can be lead/assisted.

Class 2 Mistletoe Stakes Mini - 50cm show jumping.

Class 3 Mistletoe Stakes Major - 60cm show jumping.

Class 4 Rudolph's Horse & Hound - Mini fences for 6 legs (Lead reins allowed)
PRIZES SPLIT 7 AND UNDER 8 AND OVER Small course of fences to be jumped on horseback followed by a quick change over of horse to hound by the rider to complete the course, 5 seconds added for a knock down, fastest time wins.

TIME FOR THE FANCY DRESSERS TO GET READY DURING CLASS 5

Class 5 Pudding & Sixpence 70cm Pairs Relay – The first rider jumps the course then must handover a baton before the next rider starts. 5 seconds added for a knock down, fastest time wins.

Class 6 Christmas Cheer Fancy Dress - Christmas cheer is the theme for you and your pony, dogs and family!

Class 7 Holly Stakes – 70cm Show Jumping.

OPEN CLASSES

Class 8 Ivy Stakes – 80cm show jumping. 8a Pony Club Members - The Debut Spring Festival Qualifier Individual Qualifying Class. 8b - Open

Class 9 Pudding Stakes – 90cm show jumping. 9a Pony Club Members - The PC Challenge Spring Festival Qualifier Individual Qualifying Class. 9b - Open

Class 10 Sherry & Mince Pie 90cm Pairs Relay – The first rider jumps the course then must handover a baton before the next rider starts. 5 seconds added for a knock down, fastest time wins.

Class 11 Snowman Stakes – 100cm show jumping.

Class 12 Reindeer Stakes – 110cm show jumping.

Class 13 - Time Permitting – Santa's Chase Me Charlie - Single fence to be raised, how big can Santa jump? **ALL WELCOME**

Pony Club eligibility rules for Spring Festival - Full Rules available on the PCUK website

DEBUT ELIGIBILITY

Combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:

- Represented their Branch/Centre at PC100 (Intermediate) or above at Summer Area Qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships
- Been placed 1st – 3rd as INDIVIDUAL in the PC90 (Novice) or above Pony Club Show Jumping Championships
- **Rider** is NOT eligible if they have:
- Previously competed at the Winter Series Open Grand Prix Championships; or The Pony Club Show Jumping Final at Hickstead

PC CHALLENGE ELIGIBILITY

- Combination of horse/pony and rider are NOT eligible if they have:
- Represented their Branch/Centre at PC110 (Open) Summer Area Qualifiers for The Pony Club Show Jumping Championships (this does not include any other classes held in conjunction with the Area Qualifier)

Combination of horse/pony and rider CAN qualify for both the Debut Championships and PC Challenge Championships in the same year but CANNOT also qualify for the Open Grand Prix Final.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Event will be run under Pony Club Show jumping plus Spring Qualifier 2022 Rules where applicable.
- Failure to comply with rules may result in elimination.
- The Judges decision shall be final
- The Pony Club Hat Rule is mandatory. ALL MOUNTED RIDERS MUST WEAR A HAT WITH A CURRENT AQUAMARINE TAG
- Entries will be received on a first come, first served basis.
- Horses and ponies shall be over 4 years old.
- The Organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel classes at any given time.
- Prizes, according to entries.
- Objections must be submitted in writing with a £25 deposit, within 30 minutes of the completion of the class.
- All dogs must be on a lead at all times.

LEGAL LIABILITY - The Committee, Organisers and Landowners do not hold themselves responsible for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to any horse, rider, spectator or any other person or property.

HEALTH AND SAFETY - The Organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.
