Open to ALL Ages, Abilities including lead reins.

Course Rules: Two courses will be flagged with white and green numbers (as above) competitors may jump any fence on the course that is numbered, but you must jump the fences in the correct number order i.e. 1 – 9. All fences must be jumped in the direction indicated with the RED Flag on the RIGHT, and WHITE Flag on the LEFT.

You may jump any of the two heights, e.g. at fence number 4 you may wish to jump the green fence number and at fence number 5 you may wish to try the white fence number.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **Insurance**: All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Cambridgeshire Hunt Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
2. **Safety Rules** - Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
3. **Photography**- By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer
4. **Hats** of all competitors must conform to Pony Club regulations - details at - http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/Hat_Rule_2020_FINAL.pdf and must be tagged with the new joint British Eventing, Riding Clubs and Pony Club aquamarine tag. Hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hat tagging at Secretary's tent.
5. **Body Protector** – All competitors must wear a body protector that meets BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label) - details at - http://www.pcuk.org/uploads/Body_Protector_Rule_2020.pdf
6. **Dress**: Pony Club sweatshirts or Cross Country colours permitted. No jewellery – this will be strictly adhered to. Long hair must be tied up/in a hairnet so as not obscure riders number.
7. **Whip**: If carried, must be held in the hand by the handle with the handle at the top. The whip must be “padded” and comply with the current Pony Club Rules.
8. **Competitor Times and Numbers**: All competitors will be given ride times for their entries and these will be posted on www.ponyclubresults.co.uk no later than Friday 15 April. **Competitors to provide own no. bibs and numbers to be printed at home**
9. **The organisers** reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for the misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition. and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
10. **The Judges Decisions** are final. Objections may only be made by owners or riders and must be submitted to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the final scores being posted on completion of the class, accompanied by a deposit of £20. The deposit only to be repayable if an objection is upheld.
11. **Horse and Ponies** to be 4 years old or over.
12. **VACCINATIONS**: Passports/vaccination certificates should always be carried and **checks may be carried out.**
 - Ensure that the horse (or pony) has received two injections for primary vaccination against equine influenza given no less than 21 days and no more than 92 days apart.
 - Only these two injections need to have been given before a horse/pony can attend.
 - In addition, if sufficient time has elapsed a first booster injection must be given no less than 150 days and no more than 215 days after the second injection of the primary vaccination. Subsequently, booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one year apart.
 - 7 days must elapse between injections and attending the event.
13. **All ages taken from 1st January 2022**
14. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES.**
15. **ENTRIES**: All entries are non-returnable, after close of entries.
16. **LATES ENTRIES OR AT THE COURSE WALK (SUBJECT TO SPACE) AT EXTRA COST.**

ALL ENTRY FEES INCLUDE 1st Aid
