Rallies

CHPC Rallies - Rider:

- Cream/beige/white/blue/black jodhpurs.
- Navy CHPC skinny and/or light blue CHPC polo shirt and/or navy CHPC sweatshirt.
- Black or navy hat cover.
- Hat tagged with current safety standard PC tag (Pink!)
- Long hair tied up and in a hair net if appropriate.
- Brown/black jodhpur boots/chaps or long riding boots.
- Body protectors to correct PC safety standard, must be worn for XC.
- Gloves black/blue/white.

CHPC Rallies - Horse/pony

- Plain numnah in navy, black or white. CHPC logo is allowed.
- Make sure stirrups are the correct size for your foot.

See link for stirrups that are not permitted.

Please check all stitching on bridles and saddles regularly.

XC Competition Dress

CHPC XC Dress - Rider:

- Cream/beige/white jodhpurs.
- Navy CHPC skinny with light blue CHPC polo shirt on top.
- Black or navy hat cover.
- Hat tagged with current colour PC hat tag (Pink!)
 Long hair tied up and in a hair net.
- Brown/black jodhpur boots+chaps or long riding boots.
- Body protectors to correct PC safety standard, must be worn for XC.
- Gloves black/blue/white.





CHPC XC - Horse/pony

- Plain numnah in navy, black or white. CHPC logo is allowed.
- Make sure stirrups are the correct size for your foot. See link for stirrups that are not permitted.
- Please check all stitching on bridles and saddles regularly.
- Boots for XC as appropriate.
- Immaculate turnout expected.
- Please plait for all Area competitions.



DR/SJ Competition Dress

DR/SJ Competition Rider:

- Cream/beige/white jodhpurs.
- Hacking Jacket, plus pony club badge and current test felt.
- White shirt or stock shirt.
- Pony Club tie or Pony Club stock
- Black or navy hat cover.
- Hat tagged with current colour PC hat tag (Pink!)
- Long hair tied up and in a hair net.
- Brown/black jodhpur boots/chaps or long riding boots.
- Body protectors to correct PC safety standard, must be worn for XC. Not mandatory for SJ.
- Gloves black/blue/white.

DR/SJ Competition Horse/pony

- Plain numnah in navy, black or white. CHPC logo is allowed.
- Make sure stirrups are the correct size for your foot. See link for stirrups that are not permitted.
- Please check all stitching on bridles and saddles regularly.
- Boots for sj as appropriate.
- Immaculate turnout expected.
- Please plait for all Area competitions.

Update February 2024:

Whips:

Please see the specific whip rules for your discipline using the online rule book for the most up to date rules regarding type and length.

As you will all know one of the most recent rule changes is the use of a padded short whip for jumping.

Please make yourself familiar with the rules regarding the use of the whip and not just the type.

Whips must never be used in anger.

If we see a whip used inappropriately or in a manner that might compromise a horse or pony's welfare, we reserve the right to ask you to remove it.

Spurs:

These are also in the public eye and are likely to be next under greater scrutiny.

Spur rules at competition are clearly outlined in the rule books regarding the type and the way they should be used.

It's widely agreed that the rider needs to be able to DEMONSTRATE a secure lower leg in order to use spurs effectively and safely. An understanding of the correct way to apply aids whilst wearing spurs, is insufficient.

We reserve the right to ask a member to remove spurs should we see them used inappropriately, where we see a lack skill required for their effective use, or in a manner that might compromise a horse or pony's welfare.

Please consider their appropriateness before wearing.
