**SECTION A – TURNOUT – RIDDEN**

ENTRY FEE £8.00 (C.F.P.C. members £6.00)

The classes will be judged at the same time as the Equitation class. From 9.30a.m.

- Class 1 Best turnout, lead rein
- Class 2 Best turnout, 10 years & under
- Class 3 Best turnout, riders 11 - 15 year
- Class 4 Best turnout, riders 16 years and over.

**SECTION B - EQUITATION CLASSES 9.30 a.m.**

ENTRY FEE £9.00 (C.F.P.C. members £7.00)

These classes will be judged at the same time as the Turnout class.

- Class 5 Riders on lead rein
- Class 6 Riders 10 years and under
- Class 7 Riders 11-15 years
- Class 8 Riders 16 years and over

There is a Championship open to ponies & horses that have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in classes 1 to 4

There is a Championship open to ponies & horses that have been placed 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> in classes 5 to 8

- Class 21 Small Cross Poles Horse or Pony (assistance allowed) No Elimination
- Class 22 Horse or Pony 30cm (assistance allowed) No Elimination
- Class 23 Ponies – 40cm
- Class 24 Horses – 40cm
- Class 25 Ponies – 50 cm
- Class 26 Horses – 50 cm
- Class 27 Ponies – 60 cm
- Class 28 Horses – 60 cm
- Class 29 Ponies – 70 cm
- Class 30 Horses – 70 cm
- Class 31 Ponies – 80 cm
- Class 32 Horses – 80 cm
- Class 33 Ponies – 90 cm
- Class 34 Horses – 90 cm
- Class 35 Ponies – 1m
- Class 36 Horses – 1m

## ENTRIES

- All entries should be made online using [www.horse-events.co.uk](http://www.horse-events.co.uk).
- Handlers under 16 must wear a correctly fitted riding hat in ALL in-hand classes
- All riders under 18 must wear riding Hats to standard BSI PAS015 1998, EN13841996, ASTM F1163, SNELLE2001, AS/NZS3838 1998, 2003, SAI GLOBAL at all times with the chinstrap fastened when mounted
- If you enter the Lead Rein class, you must remain on the Lead Rein for all classes.
- N. B. Once judging has commenced competitors will not be allowed to enter the ring
- All entries are Subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.
- If you have already entered via Horse Events and wish to add another class on the, you can enter and pay cash ON THE DAY
- Whilst every care is taken when preparing the timetable, some clashes may occur. It is up to competitor's to decide which class they will compete in. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN**"
- The judges decision is final
- All horses and ponies must be up to date with their vaccinations and must have a valid passport present at the show. Passports must be available for inspection if requested.
- The welfare of the horse or pony must take priority at all times. Any competitor seen to mistreat a horse or pony may be asked to leave the showground.
- Correct and safe tack must be used at all times. Riding bareback in a headcollar is not permitted.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times. Please clean up after your dog — no fouling.
- For ALL changes of horse and rider substitutions after the closing date there is a £5 charge
