- No substitutions allowed following the commencement of classes.
- Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

## CLASSES

### **Class 1 - Hatchling Stakes, kindly sponsored by Gregor Brown Farrier**

Ponies only. First round fences not to exceed 30cm - Single phase - no doubles, combinations or fillers. Teams and Individuals. Lead rein and off lead rein sections.

### **Class 2 - Nestling Stakes, kindly sponsored by Drumaw Beltex's**

First round fences not to exceed 40cm - Single phase. Teams and Individuals. Lead rein and off lead rein sections.

### **Class 3 - Fledgling Stakes, kindly sponsored by Kirkettle Farm Livery**

First round fences not to exceed 50cm - Single phase. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 4 - 60cm Stakes, kindly sponsored by J. Dow Horseboxes**

First round fences not to exceed 60cm - Single phase. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 5 - 70cm Stakes, kindly sponsored by Sinclair Photography**

First round fences not to exceed 70cm - Single phase. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 6 - Grassroots Stakes, kindly sponsored by Tower Farm Riding Stables, including Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Debut Preliminary Qualifier 2021/22**

Preliminary round Max height 80cm. Single-phase, speed 325 metres/minute. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 7 - Novice Stakes, kindly sponsored by David Harland Showjumping, including Barrier Animal Health Spring Festival Challenge Preliminary Round Qualifier 2021/22**

Preliminary round Max height 90cm. Single-phase, speed 325 metres/minute. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 8 - Intermediate Stakes, kindly sponsored by The Dick Vet Equine Hospital and Practice**

First round fences not to exceed 1m - Single phase. Teams and Individuals.

### **Class 9 - Open Stakes**

First round fences not to exceed 1.10m - Single phase. Teams and Individuals.

## Rules

1. Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2021 and Pony Club Spring Festival Show Jumping rules 2021/22 will apply. Please view Pony Club website for 2021 Hat Rules, Body Protector Rule 2021 and SJ Rules <http://www.pcuk.org/>

2. Classes 1 and 2 are for genuine novices, anyone entering Class 1 can not enter Classes 3 and above, anyone entering Class 2 can not enter Classes 4 and above.

3. Classes 6 and 7- Competitors Must be a current member of The Pony Club to enter these classes

3. The Judges Decision is Final.

4. Objections must be made in writing, accompanied by a £20 deposit to be refunded if the objection is upheld.

5. The organiser reserves the right to refuse or restrict entries. If the event is oversubscribed, current Pony Club members will be given priority.

6. In the event of cancellation due to adverse weather conditions, entry fees will be returned less £2 for administration.

7. No entry fee will be refunded without a veterinary or doctor's certificate.

8. Competitors must wear correct dress, hair nets are compulsory and horses must wear correct tack.

9. The organisers do not hold themselves responsible for anything that may happen to competitors, spectators, their property, their horse or their helpers in connection with or arising out of this show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any incident.

10. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers, all officials and stewards.
