ARENA EVENTING CLASS SCHEDULE

Rosettes awarded to 8th place

Class 1 - Fences 70 cm. Rider any age, horse/pony any height

Class 2 - Fences 80 cm. Rider any age, horse/pony any height

Class 3 - Fences 90 cm. Rider any age, horse/pony any height

Entry Fees:

£28.00 per class plus £2.00 per rider for First Aid cover.

DW(NM)PC Members £26.00 plus £2 per rider for First Aid cover.

* **Numbers** will be provided in A4 format for insertion into bibs. Competitors to bring their own bibs.

RULES

- The competition is open to all.
- No horse /pony can compete more than once in each class.
- In the event of over subscription non DWNM Pony Club members will be balloted.
- This competition will include a variety of show jumps and cross-country style jumps. It will be run as a SINGLE ROUND competition with two phases, the first phase with show jumps and the second phase with the cross-country style jumps. All competitors proceed to the second phase whether faults have been incurred or not, apart from eliminated riders. The second phase has a timed section.
- All competitors will jump both phases, the winner being the closest to the optimum time with the lowest number of faults.
- The competition will be run under Pony Club rules, so that a rider may remount after the first rider fall, elimination occurring after the second rider fall on the whole course. In the event of a horse refusal, the horse

will be eliminated on the 3rd refusal at any one fence and the 5th refusal on the whole course.

- Scoring: 4 faults for a knockdown or refusal in the show jumping phase, 10 faults for a refusal in the cross country phase. 20 faults for a rider fall in either phase. Horse fall is elimination.
- All competitors must present themselves to the Tack Check Steward 15 minutes before *their start time*. There will a maximum number of people allowed to warm up at any one time in the warm up arena.
- All hats CANNOT have fixed peaks and must comply with current PC Rule Book. Hats must be checked before competitor numbers are released. BE red tags and PC white tags. Body protectors must carry the **BETA 2009 (Level3) purple label**.
- The decision of the judges and organisers is final.
- No outside assistance (except from officials) will be allowed whilst in the arena.
- All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- All horses must be at least 4 years old.

LEGAL LIABILITY

Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers, or the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, injury, or negligence, breach of contract in any way whatsoever.
