Weather conditions Please note that the event will ALWAYS RUN, whatever the weather conditions prior to the date or on the day.

Conditions of entry

To be run in accordance with 2020 Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules. The decisions of the judges are final throughout.

For insurance purposes, all competitors must be paid-up members of their Pony Club branch.

- **Objections** Run times will be posted at the running. Any queries should be taken up with the phase steward at that point and no more than 30 minutes after the scores are put up or posted on the noticeboard. Objections must be made by the team manager please.
- **Shooting** Guns must be brought to tables in their boxes and opened only on command of the firing point steward. They must be boxed again before the competitor leaves the firing point. Guns may only be carried by those over 18 years or under the supervision of a person over 21 years. When not in use, guns must be stored in a secure place (ie, in a vehicle, out of sight). Any breach of safety rules may result in disqualification. ***Please ensure competitors are aware that footwear must not cover the ankle (ie. no boots) and all competitors shooting at the 7m distance must wear eye protection.***
- **Show Jumping** Competitors may elect to drop down a height (will incur 400 penalties) and please check the Pony Club website and tetrathlon 2020 rule book to adhere to the latest hat and back protector standards. Lead rein and in the arena assistance is allowed but will incur 200 penalties.

TEAM MANAGERS

Please:

- Indicate team members clearly on the entry form. If no team is nominated, the Organisers will select team members and no alterations will be allowed. The Organisers reserve the right to alter teams on the day if necessary due to last-minute withdrawals. This will be done before scores have been posted.
 - Make all competitors/parents aware of the Rules of the competition.
 - Mark on entry form if competitor is sharing gun, shoots with left hand, together with run score –
- CHANGES CANNOT BE MADE ON THE DAY.
