## **ENTRY FEES**

- Classes 1 to 19:** £7 per class (EPC members £6)
- Late entry surcharge:** One-off fee of £3 per rider/pony combination (not per class)
- Dressage classes:** £10 per class (EPC members £8)  
Strictly **NO** late entries for dressage
- Clear Round:** £3 per round – payable at ringside  
£5 per round for mini mini cross country
- Fun Corner:** £3 per round/entry - payable at ringside

## **CLASS/RING SUMMARY:**

- Ring 1:** Jumping Classes from cross poles to 80cm.
- Ring 2:** Best Lead Rein Pony, Leading Rein Best Rider, Very Novice Best Rider, First Ridden Best Rider, Open Best Rider, Best Rider Championship, Coloured Horse/Pony, Veteran Horse/Pony
- Ring 3:** Working Hunter Ponies, Pony Club Pony
- Ring 4:** Clear Round Jumping, Horse & Hound Jumping
- Ring 5:** Dressage – BD Intro A & BD Prelim 1
- Ring 6:** Mini Cross country Clear round
- Ring 7:** Fun Corner – Handy Pony, Fancy Dress, Pony The Judge Would Most Like To Take Home, Gymkhana Games

## **RING 1** *Commencing 9.00am prompt*

**CLASS 1**     **Cross Pole Jumping**  
Section A) Led. Section B) Assisted

**CLASS 2**     **Starter Stakes jumping**  
45-50cm. May be assisted but not led

Classes 1 and 2 are one round against the clock. Rosettes to all clears. entrants in classes 1 and 2 are not eligible to compete in classes 4 and 5.

**CLASS 3**     **Minimus Jumping**  
Fences approx.55-60cm in first round.

**Class 4**     **Novice Jumping**  
Fences approx 70cm in the first round.

**Class 5**     **Intermediate Jumping**  
Fences approx 80cm in the first round

classes 3-5 will have a jump off for all clear rounds.

## **RING 2** *Commencing 9.30am prompt*

**CLASS 6**     **Best Lead Rein Pony**  
Not exceeding 13.2hh. Rider aged 10 years and under on day of show. Lead rein must be attached to the nose band.

**CLASS 7**     **Leading Rein Best Rider**  
8 years and under on day of show. Lead rein must be attached to the nose band.

**CLASS 8**     **Very Novice Best Rider**  
10 years and under, may be assisted but not led. No cantering as a group, canter optional in individual show. Daisy rein may be used but not grass reins.  
***(Please note that this class is for genuine novice riders)***

## Ring 2 continued

### **CLASS 9 First Ridden Best Rider**

12 years and under on day of show. *Riders are not eligible to enter Class 8.*

### **CLASS 10 Best Rider Open**

Rider/Pony combination only eligible to enter one Best Rider Class (except Classes 6 and 7 may both be entered by the same combination).

**TO BE FOLLOWED BY BEST RIDER CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN TO 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACED COMPETITORS IN CLASSES 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10)

### **CLASS 11 Coloured Horse/Pony**

Horses will not be required to jump.

### **CLASS 12 Veteran Horse or Pony**

Horses or ponies aged 16 years or over – state age on entry form

if classes 11 and 12 have insufficient entries they will be run at the same time but judged separately.

## **RING 3**

*Commencing 10.30am prompt*

No combination may enter class 13, 14, & 15 if they have EVER qualified for any WHP class at BSPS or Ponies UK Championships.

### **CLASS 13 Working Hunter Pony**

Fences approx. 50cm. Riders may be assisted but not led.

### **CLASS 14 Working Hunter Pony**

Fences approx. 60cm

### **CLASS 15 Working Hunter Pony**

Fences approx. 70cm.

**TO BE FOLLOWED BY WORKING HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP (OPEN TO 1<sup>ST</sup> AND 2<sup>ND</sup> PLACED COMPETITORS IN CLASSES 13, 14 and 15) SASH AND ERIDGE PONY CLUB WHP TROPHY TO CHAMPION**

### **CLASS 16 Pony Club Pony**

Pony club members aged 16 and under on day of show. Will be required to jump a maximum of 3 obstacles. (Jumping height optional)

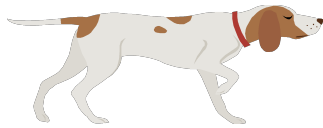
## **RING 4**

**CLEAR ROUND JUMPING** 9.00am

Starting with cross poles height increasing during the day.  
£3 per round - please pay at ringside.

**CLASS 17** Horse & Hound will commence at approximately midday  
One round against the clock rider jumps first on pony then jumps a course with dog (must be on lead).

Section A: assisted height of fences approx 40cm.  
Section B: unassisted height of fences approx 60cm.

These classes are for genuine novice horse / rider combinations  
All tests may be called.

## **RING 6            MINI MINI CROSS COUNTRY**

*11.00am -1.00pm. Entries to be taken at the cross country,*

**Clear Round – in roped off area. (Optional heights from 40-60cm)**

Body Protectors must be worn for Cross country and must meet BETA 2009 Level 3 standard (purple label).

**Maximum height of ponies for mini mini XC 14.2**

**£3 per round/entry - please pay at ringside**

**HANDY PONY** 10am –12.30pm

Negotiate a course of obstacles with your pony in the fastest time

(i) Led /Assisted            (ii) Unassisted

**FANCY DRESS** *Will not commence before 1 pm*

Entries may be individuals, pairs or groups

**PONY THE JUDGE WOULD MOST LIKE TO TAKE HOME** *approx. 1.00pm*

Open to all ponies – ridden or in hand.

# RULES

It is a condition of entry that all competitors read and abide by the following rules:

1. Show jumping classes will be run under current P.C. Show Jumping Rules (BS Rules where appropriate). Dressage classes under P.C Dressage Rules (BD Rules where appropriate)
2. Legal Liability. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers nor the Pony Club, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, accepts any liability for any accident, loss damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, servants, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
3. In the interests of safety a horse or pony, whether ridden or led, should not exceed a walk whilst on the showground, except in showing rings or designated exercise areas. Competitors disregarding this rule may be asked to leave the showground.
4. Hats must conform with the latest standards and must be tagged with the white PC label.
5. No spurs if under 12 or draw reins may be worn in any showing or jumping class
6. Dogs must be kept on short leads at all times – no extension leads.
7. The decision of the judge is final. Objections are to be made to the Secretary in writing, within half an hour of the disputed event together with a deposit of £10 which will be refunded should the objection be upheld.
8. Legal Liability :-Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
9. Health and Safety:- The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
10. The organisers reserve the right to cancel or alter classes, refuse entries without explanation and to disqualify competitors.
11. No entry money will be refunded.
12. No horse or pony may be left unattended whilst tied to a trailer or horsebox.
13. ALL times given are approximate. Whilst every effort will be made to keep within these, the organisers cannot be held responsible for any deviation.
14. All horses/ponies must 4 years old or over on the day of the show.
15. No barbeques to be lit in the showground.
16. No litter to be left or mucking out of trailers or horseboxes in the showground.

Your signature on the entry form, or payment of an entry fee, shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the above rules and conditions
