At the Zones, Poppy took Willow's place in the Vixens as Willow was on holiday and Scarlett took Sorena's place in the Seniors. Juniors were 7th and Seniors 13th, but both put on solid performances and were incredibly stoic and showed great team spirit in the thoroughly miserable weather!

Two 80 teams - one (Lola Cave, Illa Fairbrother, Florence Auckland and Willow Roberts) finished on 4 and came 7<sup>th</sup>. The other 80cn team (Marcie Reynolds-Eaton, Chloe Chippendale, Ava Jamieson, Amelia Lewin) finished on 8 and came 10<sup>th</sup>.

The 90 team (Imogen Mann, Ruby Kopel, Nina Morley, Audrey Hughes) finished on 4 and came 2<sup>nd</sup>.

# **JCB Pony Club National Championships**

QHPC members did very well to qualify for Championships. Members coming in the first 10 placings were:

Tetrathlon – Open boys Joel Harby came 5th with second best swim and Josh Duncombe came 8th. Open girls Jade England came 6th with 1400 ride and the team, with Lilia Chippendale and Georgie Daynes, won overall.

Junior boys team of Fred Daynes, Jacob Duncombe, Oscar Pickering, Sam Daynes, Toby Duncombe overall came 3rd.

Joel and Lilia won the prizes for the youngest boy and girl members to complete the competition. Dressage – Jade England came 9th in the Open and Lily Walker came 3rd in the Intermediate. Show Jumping – Team of Annie Thompson, Molly Starmer, Lilia Chippendale and Sophie Johnson came 5th.

Eventing – Jade England came 2nd in the Chairman's Cup.

H&P Care - Mini team of Polly Morley, Tabitha Morley and Eva Henton Young came 9th.

# **Regional Championships** had a fabulous weekend.

*Dressage* – 70 team all did good tests with Lily Spence coming 11<sup>th</sup>.

2 Individual 80 with Willow Roberts coming 14th.

Eventing – 70 Individual Katie Haynes came 12th.

80 team (Chloe Chippendale, Florence Auckland, Imogen Mann) came 6<sup>th</sup>. Imogen 6th in her section.

# Successes in early 2024

# **Spring Festival Finals**

*Arena Eventing* – 70cm Lola Cave qualified, but unfortunately had 4 faults at the Finals. 90cm Oscar Pickering came 5<sup>th</sup>.

*Dressage* – 5 members Qualified: Izzy Hall and Georgina Shepard (Grassroots), Brooke England (Novice), Lilia Chippendale (Intermediate) and Jade England (Open). All produced lovely tests on the day with Jade finishing 11<sup>th</sup> in her section.

Showjumping – Jade England qualified with a win in the 1m class but unfortunately at the finals had 4 faults in the first round which put her out of contention on the day.

**Winter Triathlon Championships –** we had seven members qualify. The standard at Tri champs is notoriously high and placings in the top ten are rare for our area but we absolutely smashed it this year - just amazing!

*Open Boys*: Joel Harby 9<sup>th</sup> (= best swim which was one of the most exciting swims to watch) and Joshua Duncombe 17<sup>th</sup>.

Open Girls: Jade England 6th and Lilia Chippendale 38th.

Junior Boys: Oscar Pickering 6th, Jacob Duncombe 7th (with best shoot) and Toby Duncombe 14th.
