ROSETTES: Rosettes will be awarded to 8th place in each class according to entries. Competitors in classes 1 & 2 may not enter class 4 or above.

No lead reins will be allowed except in class 1 & 2

ENTRY FEES: Classes 1,2 & 3 £12, Classes 4 & 5 £14 DEBUT & PC CHALLENGE qualifier classes 6 & 7 £16

NUMBER BIBS: You will need to print your own numbers for a Number Bib which you will need to buy if you don't have one.

Rules

1. The competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2022 and the Show Jumping Spring Festival Debut, Spring Festival & Open Grand Prix Show Jumping rules where applicable. The decision of the judge is final.
2. Hats conforming to the current Pony Club dress rules must be worn with the chinstrap fastened whilst mounted.
3. Hairnets must be worn.
4. No Horse or pony to enter more than 3 classes
5. In all Pony Club Show Jumping, excessive use of the whip including repeated slapping down the shoulder is prohibited. The rules state that the whip may be used a maximum of twice for any one incident. Excessive use may result in elimination at the discretion of the Judges.
6. In case of high entries some classes may be run as two phase.
7. Pony Club members only may compete.
8. No refunds after closing date
9. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
10. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
11. **All horses and ponies must be fully vaccinated against equine flu according to the Pony Club Rules.**

Barrier Spring Festival 2022/2023 - England & Wales

Arena Eventing, Dressage and Show Jumping competitions are running across England and Wales, with the finals being held 11th - 12th February 2023 at Arena UK.

The Barrier Spring Festival is a competition series for Dressage, Show Jumping and Arena Eventing. Riders will compete to qualify for the Finals. The qualifying route for each sport is as follows:

Show Jumping – Preliminary Rounds will be held up to the date of the Area Competition to enable Members to qualify for their Area Competition. Each Area will hold an Area Qualifying Competition between 1st December 2022 and 31st January 2023 (or earlier at the discretion of the Area Representative) for those who qualified at a Preliminary Round. Those who were successful at their Area Competition will qualify for the Final in February 2023.

Dressage – Each Area will hold an Area Qualifying Competition anytime before 31st January 2023. Members will compete at their Area Competition to aim to qualify for the Final in February 2023. There will be no Preliminary Rounds, but Branches & Centres are encouraged to run Friendly competitions to prepare members for the Area Competitions.

Arena Eventing – Each Area will hold an Area Qualifying Competition anytime before 31st January 2023. Members will compete at their Area Competition to aim to qualify for the Final in February 2023. There will be no Preliminary Rounds, but Branches & Centres are encouraged to run Friendly competitions to prepare members for the Area Competitions.
