ENTRY CONDITIONS:

- To be run in accordance with Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024 amended to local conditions.
- Queries may only be raised via the Organiser.

RESULTS:

- Save for Class 1 and 3, all results will be published on <u>www.ponyclubresults.co.uk</u> and prizes given on the day.
- The Pairs Classes (1 & 3) will be published at the end of each class at the Secretary Gazebo near the start of the course. Once results are published, rosettes will be available from the Secretary following a 30 minute dispute period per class.

Rules:

- 1. The competition will be run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2024 except for cross country ruling as per this schedule.
- 2. All competitors must wear hats and body protectors to current Pony Club Standards. Hats must always have chinstraps fastened when mounted.
- 3. It is recommended that all riders wear a medical armband and it is compulsory for a rider to wear a PC/BE medical armband if they have a medical condition that may impact on their care in the case of an emergency. Conditions that are relevant includes serious past injuries/surgery, chronic health problems such as diabetes, long-term medications and allergies.
- 4. Horses and ponies must be at least 5 years old.
- 5. Horses and ponies may only be entered in a maximum of two classes.
- 6. Any outside interference or assistance will result in elimination.
- 7. All dogs to be kept on short leads.
- 8. Apart from Classes 1 and 2, three refusals will incur elimination and the competitor will be asked to leave the course at a walk.
- 9. There will be an optimum time for classes 2a, 2b, 4a, 4b, 5a, 5b, 6a and 6b.
- 10. Stop watches only allowed for classes 5a, 5b, 6a and 6b.
- 11. The organisers reserve the right to close classes before the closing date if classes are full.
- 12. No entries will be accepted by telephone or email for this event and no entries will be accepted on the day.
- 13. The Judge's decision is final.
- 14. Photographic Rights When entering this competition all competitors and their parents or guardians give permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage of persons taking part in this Pony Club event to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club
