Winter League 2024

Rules

- The Winter League in 2024 will be run in association with Enniskillen Horse and Pony Show. Some of the legs of the Winter League will be at the Enniskillen Horse and Pony Show unregistered events at Necarne. Two legs of the League will include qualifiers for the Spring Festival Showjumping final. These will be notified to members when confirmed.
- 2. Dates for the League in 2024 will be:

Saturday 12th October (Ekn H&P Show Jump Cross) Saturday 26th October Pony Club Halloween Rally) Sunday 27th October (Ekn H&P Show Unregistered Show) Sunday 1st December (Ekn H&P Show Unregistered Show) ####One further date to be added####

- 3. Classes in the league will be as follows:crosspoles 40cm 50cm 60cm 70cm 80cm 90cm
- 4. Each pony/horse and rider combination can jump a 2nd round, regardless of faults in the first round.
- 5. The height of jumps in the practice arena will not exceed the height of jumps of the competition being jumped at that time. Jumps in the practice arena will be marked, and competitors must jump in the correct direction, with the red flag on their right and the white flag on their left. If the practice jump is not flagged, it must be jumped in the direction as advised by the official in charge. If the practice arena is not available, an opportunity for warm up will be made available before each class. Riders to use only the jump advised as the practice fence.

6. At each week of the League, points will be awarded as follows:2 clear rounds – 4 points
1 clear round, 2 points

1 clear round –2 points completion of 2 rounds – 1 point

- 7. Each horse/pony and rider combination can choose a max of 2 classes to compete in at the League. Points will be displayed on the Fermanagh Branch website throughout the League.
- 8. Final League placings will be determined by adding the points awarded to each horse/pony and rider combination at their best 3 legs of the League. To be eligible for prizes in the League Final, each pony/horse and rider combination must attend at least 3 legs of the League.
- 9. In the event of 2 or more riders having the same points overall, then the points on the final day will be the deciding factor in relation to overall placings. In the event of 2 or more riders still being tied, then they will be allocated a tied place, but the prizes awarded will be allocated on a ballot basis.
- 10. The highest placed member in each class will be awarded a cup at the Christmas Function and Awards Night in December, however, a member can only win one cup. In the event that a member wins more than one class at the League, one of the cups will roll down to the 2nd placed prizewinner.
- 11. In the event of any dispute in relation to Showjumping faults, the decision of the Showjumping Judge is final. In the event of any dispute in relation to placings at the League, the decision of the Branch District Commissioner is final.
- 12. Riders must be current members of the Fermanagh Harriers Branch of the Pony Club on the date that they participate each leg of the League.
- 13. Submitting an entry into any class at the League constitutes acceptance of these rules.
