RED COURSE – "Have a Go" at Cross Country" - Shortened course. Max height 65 cm - For very novice combination

Class 1 – Clear Round PAIRS Hunter Trial - opportunity for truly novice combination to follow round more experienced combination –One of the pair must be novice combination

Class 2 - Clear Round Individual Hunter Trial – combination in this class may only enter YELLOW course classes

Class 3 PAIRS – Hunter Trial Any combination Qualifier Class for Eland Lodge National Hunter Trial Championship 2024 (Pairs 70cm)

Class 4 - Novice Hunter Trial - Combination not to have been placed 1st – 3rd in Hunter Trial or Eventer Trial at this height or above (4A) Pony Club Members (4B) Non-PC members

Class 5 Hunter Trial – Open to all (5A) Pony Club Members (5B) Non-PC members Qualifier Class for Eland Lodge National Hunter Trial Championship 2024 (70cm)

Class 6 Eventer Trial – Open to all (6A) Pony Club Members (6B) Non-PC members

BLUE COURSE Max height XC and SJ – 90cm

Course Walking : The Course may be walked after 3.00 pm on Saturday 20 April. - we would prefer all competitors to use this opportunity to walk the course but if not possible please build in sufficient time to walk on day of competition. There will be a Mini Hunter Trial taking place in the fields so please keep to route marked for Course Walk. Dogs on Leads at all times please

Classes 1 and 2 – Rosette to all clear rounds. Rosettes to 6th place for all class sections in Classes 3 - 9 Rosettes to 6th place for Fitzwilliam members in Classes 4 - 9.

Classes 3 – 9 to be judged on clear round and an undisclosed optimum time

Eventer Trial competitors go straight onto the Cross Country course having completed the show jumping so must be tacked up for Cross Country prior to start of class

Eland Lodge National Hunter Trial Championship 2024 – Riders placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd with a clear round in Classes 5, 7 or 9 are eligible to compete at the Eland Lodge National Hunter Trial Championship Final, held on 28 & 29 September 2024. Please ensure you read these conditions of entry – by entering the event you have agreed to abide by these Rules CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. Health & Safety Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
- 2. Legal Liability Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 3. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for the misuse of whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse in poor or lame condition. and to refuse any entry for any reason and at their sole discretion.
- 4. Non Pony Club competitors are <u>not</u> covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Fitzwilliam Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.
- 5. Safety Rules Failure to comply with safety rules will result in elimination
- 6. **Photography-** By entry to this competition competitors agree to being photographed by the Official Photographer
- Hats of all competitors must conform to Pony Club regulations details are in PC Eventing Rule book 2024 (pages 23-25) which can be downloaded at https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/ and must be tagged with the joint British Eventing, Riding Clubs and Pony Club PINK tag. Hats must be worn with chinstrap fastened at all times when mounted. Hat tagging at Secretary's tent.
- 8. Body Protector NEW– All competitors must wear a body protector that meets the BETA 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label) details at page 27- https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/
- 9. Whips must comply to Pony Club regulations details at page 29 https://pcuk.org/officials/rulebooks/
- 10. **Dress**: Cross country colours may be worn. Long sleeves compulsory.
- 11. No recording device is permitted (e.g Head or bridle camera).
- 12. Stop watches may be worn at PC 90 and PC 100 level (i.e Classes 7 9)
- 13. The Judges decisions are final.
- 14. No horse/pony may be ridden by more than one competitor in any one class. It is advised that horses/ponies should not go round course more than twice on the day.
