All entries are subject to a non-refundable £1.20 booking fee.





WITHDRAWALS AND REFUNDS

If a Branch or Centre withdraw a team or individual, **prior to the closing date for entries**, a full refund less the booking fee will be given.

Withdrawals after the closing date will NOT be refunded except on the production of a valid Doctor's or Vet's certificate.

In the event of abandonment, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. To be run in accordance with **The Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2024**.
2. Competitors and those responsible for them, must be conversant with The Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book 2024, with particular regard to dress and tack.
3. **Competitors must download and print their numbers from Pony Club Results.** These will be available when the times are published. Numbers must be displayed front and back in a number bib and must be worn at all times when mounted. Handwritten numbers will **NOT** be accepted.
4. Competitors must bring their own number bib.
5. Any Entry Queries should be raised with your Branch DC or Centre Proprietor.
6. **Photographic Rights** - competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club.
7. **A valid passport and vaccination record** must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.
