We need to know if feed programme has changed for camp Note: All Campers are required to bring minimal feed such as chaff/carrots so that their ponies aren't upset by other ponies eating around them		Jodhpurs/ breeches – beige/cream/white for competition day, plain dark colours (navy, black etc) can be worn on other days if preferred but NOT bright or patterned	
Feed Bowl x 2 - No handles		Flamstead polo shirts/sweatshirt/rugby shirt for every day except show days. No HOODIES allowed riding	
Buckets x 2 (1 large and 1 small) -water & tack cleaning		Cross-country colours may be worn for cross-country (must be long sleeved)	
1 bag of shavings – No STRAW please (suggest bringing larger size shavings as easier to remove from stable at end of camp)		Show jacket and White Shirt for Show Demo Day Pony Club Tie, badge and Felt
