2 x Large Haynets FILLED (Always have one ready for when you have gone home and it can be given to the pony if needed) Hay will be provided.		Camp Clothing Required	
Hard Feed for the week and if required any supplements clearly labelled. Feed should be ready mixed in small bags for AM/PM in large feed sack Feed requirements and amount of hay in kilos to be written down and handed in with passport. We need to know if feed programme has changed for camp Note: All Campers are required to bring minimal feed such as chaff/carrots so that their ponies aren't upset by other ponies eating around them		Jodhpurs/ breeches – beige / white or plain dark colours (navy, black etc) can be worn	
Feed Bowl x 2 - No handles		Flamstead polo shirts/sweatshirt/rugby shirt/ fleece. These can be worn instead of white shirts. <b>No HOODIES allowed riding</b>	
Buckets x 2 (1 large and 1 small) -water & tack cleaning		Cross-country colours may be worn for cross-country (must be long sleeved)	
1/2 bag of shavings – No STRAW please (suggest bringing larger size shavings as easier to remove from stable at end of camp)		Riding Boots must be worn in and comfy (Long Boots or Jodhpur Boots and Chaps & Jodhpur clips x 2 sets) Boot Polish & Brush & Cloth	
Numnahs/saddlecloths Girth		Back/Body protector. (Compulsory for XC)	
Head collar & 2 lead rope (incase of breakages)		Hat - (hat without fixed peak essential for cross-country) Must be Tagged	
Bridle inc martingale / neck strap for XC any bit changes for jumping or flat		Gloves x 2 pairs in case one gets wet.	
Saddle including buckle guards, stirrups with treads, spare peacock rubbers if used.		Waterproof trousers, Waterproof Coats etc. (We always get one day wet)	
Fly Spray		Spare Shorts x 2 , (1 for water fight) Spare T-shirts x 2 (1 for water fight) Spare Sweatshirt	
Full grooming kit – including: Body Brush, Mane and Tail Comb, Metal curry comb, Plastic curry comb, Hoof Pick, sponges (for body, eyes, & nose and separate for dock) shampoo, sweat scraper, hoof oil and brush & Plaiting Kit *stain remover		Wellies or Yard Boots for working around the horses Trainers or comfortable footwear for non- yard activities	

Mucking out equipment: wheelbarrow, fork, poo picker or Skip bucket & Gloves (whatever you find easiest)		Hairnet (and spares) for long hair
