ENTRIES

Only open to Area 12 Pony Club branch and centre members.

Entries should be made via your Dressage Team Manager and with the approval of the branch District Commissioner of your pony club branch.

Booking fees are payable direct to horse-events.co.uk when placing your entry and are nonrefundable and on a per class basis.

Conditions of Entry

- 1. **Legal Liability:** Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 2. **Health & Safety:** Organisers of this event have taken the reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards
- 3. **Reasonable Adjustment**: Any requests for Reasonable Adjustment must be made by the closing date. https://pcuk.org/officials/equality-diversity/reasonable-adjustment/
- 4. **Rules:** The event will be run under <u>Pony Club Dressage Rules 2025</u> and it is the responsibility of the competitors to make sure that they understand and adhere to the rules.
- 5. **Vaccination:** The event venue stipulates all horses/ponies entering the event site must comply with 2025 Pony Club vaccination rules passports must accompany all horses/ponies and spot checks may be undertaken
- 6. **Hat-Tagging:** Please ensure that the riding hat is tagged in line with the pony club rules (pink tags). Yellow hat tags are required if wearing spurs.
- 7. **Reservation of Rights:** The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class/ amalgamate sections where there are insufficient entries or split classes if oversubscribed and reserve the right to disqualify anyone for misuse of the whip or spurs, dangerous riding or any horse/pony in poor lame condition, and to refuse any entry for any reason at their sole discretion.
- 8. **Withdrawal and abandonment:** The event will follow 2025 withdrawal and abandonment criteria (Rule 7 and 8) regarding refunds: If a member, branch or centre withdraws a team or individual prior to the closing date for a competition, a full refund of entry will be made, less an administration charge of £5. Withdrawals after the closing date for a competition

will not be refunded. In the event of a competition being abandoned, for whatever reason, a refund of 50% of the entry fee will be given.

- 9. **Tests:** Copies of tests can be downloaded from the pony club website.
- 10. Time & Results: We will use Pony Club Results for times and results.
- 11. Lunging: No Lunging will be allowed on the day.
