CLASS 1: PC80 TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER Kindly sponsored by Hamptons

ENTRY FEE £29 Individual + booking fees

This is a two-round competition.

Please refer to the Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book 2025 for eligibility. For individuals and teams of 3 or 4 riders. For teams the best 3 scores will count.

The top 6 teams will qualify for the Regional Championships held on 30 & 31 August at Aston Le Walls, as well as the top 16 individuals WHO HAVE NOT QUALIFIED AS PART OF A TEAM.

Fences in 1st round 80cm; 2nd round 80cm with two single fences at 85cm which will be run as a Single Phase and in the case of a tie after 2 rounds the time taken in the second phase of the second round will be used to decide the results and there will not be a jump off.

Rosettes will be awarded to teams and individuals in 1st – 6th place

No horse (or pony) ridden in Class 1 can be ridden in Class 3, 4 or 5.

N.B. (Rule 36b): If a Team is eliminated in the first round any member not eliminated will be allowed to jump in the second round. If a team member is eliminated in the first round he/she may jump again in the second round, provided the Team has not been eliminated, and is eligible to count.

CLASS 2: PC70 TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING AND PC70 PLUS (INDIVIDUAL ONLY) REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIER

Section A- Riders 13 and under Kindly sponsored by HG IFA Ltd

Section B- (70 PLUS) – Riders 14 and over Kindly sponsored by Charlotte Fountain – Master Saddle Fitter

ENTRY FEE £29 Individual + booking fees

This is a two-round competition.

Please refer to the Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book 2025 for eligibility. For individuals and teams of 3 or 4 riders. For teams the best 3 scores will count.

PC70 - The top 6 teams will qualify for the Regional Championships held on 30 & 31 August at Aston Le Walls, as well as the top 16 individuals WHO HAVE NOT QUALIFIED AS PART OF A TEAM.

PC70 PLUS - the first 5 placed individuals will qualify

Note teams must comprise riders in section A

Fences in 1st round 70cm; 2nd round 70cm with two single fences at 75cm which will be run as a Single Phase and in the case of a tie after 2 rounds the time taken in the second phase of the second round will be used to decide the results and there will not be a jump off.

Rosettes will be awarded to teams and section A individuals in $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place and section B individuals in $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place.

No horse (or pony) ridden in Class 2 can be ridden in Class 3, 4 or 5.

N.B. If a Team is eliminated in the first round any member not eliminated will be allowed to jump in the second round. If a team member is eliminated in the first round he/she may jump again in the second round, provided the Team has not been eliminated, and is eligible to count.

CLASS 3: 40cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING

Kindly sponsored by JRG Pet Equestrian

Rides in class 3 only can be led or assisted. All riders will be competing in the same section.

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 40cm.

Rosettes will be awarded to individuals in $1^{st} - 8^{th}$ place and Teams in $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ place. Special rosettes will be awarded to all competitors jumping a clear round.

No rider competing in Class 3 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

CLASS 4: 50cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING

Kindly sponsored by ELLIOTT OF LONDON

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 50cm.

Rosettes will be awarded to individuals in 1st - 8th place and Teams in 1st - 6th place.

No rider competing in Class 4 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

CLASS 5: 60cm TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL JUMPING

Kindly sponsored by Orchid Property Group

Single phase; height of fences will be approximately 60cm.

Rosettes will be awarded to individuals in 1st - 8th place and Teams in 1st - 6th place.

No rider competing in Class 5 can ride in Class 1 or 2.

Notes: Classes 3, 4 and 5 will run consecutively in the same ring.

Clear rounds will qualify for Area 12 Showjumping Championships 2025 to be held on 26

October 2025 at BCA.

Class 1 & 2 Entry Fee: £29 Individual + booking fees

Classes 3 – 5 Entry Fee: £17 Individual per class + booking fees

Note: In all classes individual entries will be added together to create mixed Teams wherever possible.

ENTRIES

All qualifier class entries (Class 1 and 2) must be approved by your Branch DC or Centre Proprietor.

For all classes, once entries close, a list of entries from each Branch/Centre will be sent to DCs/Proprietors for the allocation of Team Places.

After the closing date, all substitutions may be made only in accordance with The Pony Club Showjumping Rules 2025.

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CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. No pony or horse may compete in more than 2 classes and the same combination is only permitted to compete in Classes of consecutive heights except for no horse ridden in Class 1 or 2 can be ridden in any other class.
- 2. All classes are run under the guidance of the Pony Club Show Jumping 2025 Rules.
- 3. The decision of the Judge and Steward is final.
- 4. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.
- 5. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at the Event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.
- 6. There is to be no outside assistance (except for Class 3 40cm), leading around jumps or lunging.
- 7. Any fall will automatically count as elimination, competitors to leave the Ring unmounted.
- 8. The use of foul language and miss-use of spurs will not be tolerated and will lead to immediate elimination.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the current Pony Club vaccination rules 2024. https://pcuk.org/media/the-pony-club-equine-influenza-vaccinationrule-2024-v7.pdf

- 11. All competitors must download and print their numbers from www.ponyclubresults.co.uk.

 These will be available when times are published. Numbers must be displayed front and back in a number bib and must be worn at all times when mounted. Competitors must bring their own number bib. 1 copy of the number is to be displayed in the front of vehicle on entry to Showground.
- 12. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure their dress and tack complies with current pony club regulations. All hats must be tagged with current tag. Any competitor found to be in breach of these regulations may be disqualified at any time during or after the competition.
