Class 3 - PC70 – 70cm age restriction 13 years and under

Class 4 - PC80 - 80cm no age restriction

Class 5 - PC90 - 90cm no age restriction

Class 6 - PC100- 100cm no age restriction

(The heights given are the heights in Section A, Section B may increase by a maximum of 10cm).

Entry Fee: Class 1 £12 Classes 2 - 6 £16

RULES SUMMARY

1. All Classes to be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025 over a single-phase course divided into two sections – section A, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be untimed or time allowed; section B, over 5 to 7 obstacles, to be timed. Maximum 12 obstacles in total. The rules can be found here Show Jumping | The Pony Club UK

Class 1 will be over a reduced number of obstacles in each section with a maximum of 10.

- 2. All classes will be run in accordance with Area 5 Winter League Rules to accommodate WL and non-WL teams and individuals with appropriate course changes where necessary. Points will be awarded in accordance with the Area 5 Winter League Rules. The rules can be seen here 2025-26-Area-5-Pony-Club-Winter-League-Show-Jump-Rules-Final-19th-August-2025.pdf
- 3. Branches entering more than one team in any one class must clearly identify their Winter League Team and name their teams to distinguish.
- 4. Ages as of 1st January 2025 PC Membership will be confirmed with branch.

- 5. Whips In all Pony Club Show Jumping, excessive use of the whip, including repeated slapping down the shoulder, is prohibited. The rules state that the whip may be used a maximum of three times during any round.
- 6. Passports for all horses and ponies MUST be carried and available for inspection and prove vaccination valid in accordance with the Pony Club Equine Influenza Rules, see:

- 7. There will be a course change between each Class and a course walk before the start of each Class.

INFORMATION

- 1. Team and Individual rosettes to 6th in WL Classes 2, 3, 4,5 and 6. Individual rosettes to 6th for Class 1.
- 2. Pony Club Saddlery and Dress Rules apply.
- 3. Members must print their own numbers.
- 4. Please do not muck out horseboxes in the car park. There are dedicated muck skips, please use them. Please do not put muck in litter bins.
- 5. Please put litter in the bins provided or take it home with you. Please do not put litter in the muck skips.
- 6. Catering Van onsite all day
- 7. Horses/Ponies Should not be tied up to the outside of horseboxes/trailers and left unattended. No haynets tied to the outside of horseboxes.
- 8. Parking will be tight on the day, please follow the instructions given by parking stewards on the day. Lorries are to be parked at the college car park on the left at the top of the hill upon entry. Please park tidily and as close as safely possible to other vehicles. Cars to be parked in the designated area for cars.
- 9. There will be no St John's Ambulance or equivalent on site during the competition.
- 10. Accidents All accidents must be reported to the Organiser.
