Class 1: PC110 Sponsored by Shorefields Supplies	£26	1st round 1.10m, 2nd round 1.15m. Double clear teams and individuals progress to the jump off. Class will be split into ponies & horses, jump distances will be altered accordingly. JCB National Championship Qualifier.
Class 2: PC100 Sponsored by Bay Horse Equine Laundry	£26	First round 1.00m, second round 1.05m Single phase, second half of round two timed. No jump off. JCB National Championship Qualifier.
Class 3: PC90 Sponsored by Dent Devils	£26	1st round 90cm, 2nd round 95cm Single phase, 2nd half of round two timed. No jump off. JCB National Championship Qualifier.
Class 4: PC80 Sponsored by George's Kitchen	£26	1st round 80cm, 2nd round 80cm with two single fences at 85cm Single phase, 2nd half of round two timed. No jump off. Regional Grassroots Championship Qualifier.
Class 5A: PC70 Sponsored SC Psychology Class 5B: PC70 Plus Sponsored by Shorefields Supplies	£26	1st round 70cm, 2nd round 70cm with two single fences at 75cm. Single phase, 2nd half of round two timed. No jump off. PC70 Plus, individuals only. Regional Grassroots Championship Qualifiers.
Class 6: Friendly 60 Sponsored by Shorefields Supplies	£16	One round single phase, 2nd half to be timed. Teams and individuals. Teams to be made up from individual entries and emailed to lanaster@pc.org by Branch DC's within 24 hours after closing date. Aimed at novice combinations not to have previously competed at PC80 or above at Area competitions. Prize for the highest placed rider 10 yrs and under.
Class 7: Friendly 50 Sponsored by Shorefields Supplies	£16	One round single phase, 2nd half to be timed. Teams and individuals. Teams to be made up from individual entries and emailed to lanaster@pc.org by Branch DC's within 24 hours after closing date. Aimed at novice combinations not to have previously competed at PC70 or above at Area competitions. Prize for the highest placed rider 10 yrs and under.

ENTRIES

To complete your entry, you will need your membership number & the name of your Branch/Centre. To enter a team you will need the team name, given by your Branch/Centre.

Combinations may enter two adjacent height classes. (110 & 100, 100 & 90, 90 & 80, 80 & 70, 70 & 60, 60 & 50).

Should any rider require reasonable adjustments to be made to support their access to the event, please make these known at the time of the entry in the comments section. This will enable the entries secretary to consider these requests in advance of the competition.

All entries are subject to a non-refundable booking fee as stated online.

First Aid cover charge of £3.00 per rider will be taken upon entry.

TEAM & INDIVIDUAL ENTRIES

The Area competition comprises:

- i. The Team Competition
- ii. The Individual Competition which is open to all competitors in the Team Competition, whose scores are automatically counted for this competition, and to additional individual competitors.

Branch teams for each class should be made up of 3 or 4 members.

Mixed teams, comprising members from 2 branches, are permitted for the Area competition as per Show Jumping Rules 2025

ENTRY CONDITIONS

- To be run in accordance with Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2025
- Please remember it is the member's responsibility to ensure that they comply with the Pony Club rules.
- DCs - Please ensure your members comply with 2025 eligibility re hat tagging, body protectors, spurs rule and that a responsible adult is present.
- Female riders may wear 2 tone jodhpurs – white & navy insert or white & black insert.
- Competitor numbers to be 'print at home' and worn with own number bib.
- Late entries may be accepted at the organiser's discretion if numbers allow. Late Entry Surcharge £5.00.
- Queries may only be raised to the Event Secretary by the DC or their appointee. Protests/objections will be managed as per Rule 41.
- Photographic Rights – competitors and their parents/guardians have given permission for any photographic and/or film or TV footage taken of persons or horses/ponies taking part in Pony Club events to be used and published in any media whatsoever for editorial purposes, press information or advertising by or on behalf of the Pony Club and/or Official Sponsors of the Pony Club. Please advise on entry if this not the case for any member.
- A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection by event officials if requested. Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Show Jumping Rule Book 2025.
