2	Restricted Intro Open to combinations who have not previously achieved a score of over 63% at prelim level or above. It is anticipated that upon winning this class the same combination will not re-enter this class at subsequent events. This class is for Novice riders and not experienced riders regardless of the horse they are riding.	Intro 2 2024
3	Open Intro Open to combinations that do not have BD points and have not previously achieved a score of 67% at prelim level or above.	Intro 3 2024
4	Pony Club Grassroots PC80 Open to combinations including pony club members and non-members. Great practice for the members for the winter league dressage competitions! Test is available to download online.	Pony Club Grassroots PC80 2026
5	Restricted Prelim Open to combinations that do not have BD points and have not previously achieved a score of over 67% at prelim level or above. It is anticipated upon winning this class the same combination will not re-enter this class at subsequent competitions.	Preliminary 3 2024
6	Open Prelim Open to combinations who have not previously achieved a score of over 70% at Novice level.	Preliminary 1 2024
