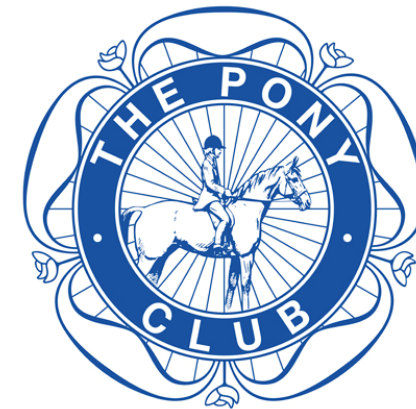

Dogs are only allowed in the car park and must be on a lead.

1. All our events may be cancelled without notice due to adverse weather. In the event of adverse weather it is recommended that you check the website before departing. www.horse-events.co.uk

2. Correct riding attire must be worn at all times when mounted and also for dismounted prize giving.

3. Hats meeting current Pony Club standards must be worn at all times when mounted. All pony club competitors must have their hats tagged with a PC tag by their Branch DC prior to the event. All hats will be checked on collection of number from the secretary.

4. Body protectors, which are up to the current Pony Club standard, are compulsory for cross country and medical armbands must be worn.

5. For Pony Club members, spurs are only allowed if members are B test holders and wearing their felts, or carrying a letter from their DC giving permission.

6. A vet will be available all day and there will be a farrier on call. It is the responsibility of the individual whose horse is being treated to settle all fees.

7. Competitors eliminated may continue on at the discretion of the judge but if asked to leave the course must do so at a walk.

8. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.

9. Horse/pony may not compete more than twice during the day.

10. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate sections or change the age limits dependent on entries.

11. All non Pony Club competitors are not covered by The Pony Club insurance and must have their own third party cover. The Grafton Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

12. Age as of 1st January 2018.

13. Horseware Ireland National Hunter Trials Qualifiers. Those placed 1st to 3rd and with a Clear Round in classes 5-7 will qualify for the final in 2019.
