Class 1	Clear round	Max height 30 cm	£4.00
Class 2	BEGINNER CLASS	Max height 40 cm	£7.00
Open to Lead Reins / pony / rider combinations in their first year of competition that have not yet been placed in Show jumping competition.			
Class 3	MINI NOVICE	Max height 50 cm	£7.00
Class 4	NOVICE	Max height 60 cm	£7.00
Any horse / rider combination who has jumped successfully at Open height is not eligible for this class.			
Class 5	NOVICE PLUS	Max height 70 cm	£7.00
Class 6	MINOR INTERMEDIATE	Max height 80 cm	£7.00
Class 7	INTERMEDIATE	Max height 90 cm	£7.00
Class 8	OPEN	Max height 1.0 m	£7.00

Coronavirus Requirements: The competition is subject to cancellation or change if coronavirus regulation changes. It is open to competitors from Level 1 only. Track and Trace will be in force for everyone attending. Competitor times will be advised by email once payment is received and published on the IPC website (see link above) and open facebook page on the Friday beforehand.

FIRST AID COVER WILL BE AVAILABLE. Toilets will be available. NO DOGS PLEASE. ROSETTES WILL BE AWARDED TO SIXTH PLACE (except for class 1 for which rosettes will be awarded to all clear rounds but there will be no placings). NO HORSE OR PONY MAY JUMP MORE THAN 3 CLASSES IN TOTAL. POINTS WILL BE ACUMULATED OVER THE WINTER COMPETITIONS TO DECIDE OVERALL LEAGUE PLACES.

DRESS CODE: RIDERS ARE EXPECTED TO BE TIDY but Hacking or Show jackets are not necessary. HATS MUST CONFORM TO PC STANDARD. FOOTWEAR must have smooth sole and defined heel. No earrings or piercings, please.

Liability and 'Flu vaccine requirements, entry form /

Liability

Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event nor The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. Entries are only accepted on this basis.

The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

Only Pony Club competitors are covered by The Pony Club insurance; Non-members must have their own third party cover. The Inverness-shire Branch of The Pony Club and the organisers of this event are not legally responsible for non Members and their insurance will not cover you.

*****EQUINE FLU PRECAUTIONS ARE IN PLACE PLEASE OBSERVE STEWARDS' REQUESTS*****

We have to implement some safety rules for the well-being of our ponies, those of others and the horses at the livery yard.

So, as per BEF recommendations and those being followed by PC, on the day we will require all horses and ponies to have up to date 'flu vaccines.

What this means:

All horses/ponies attending must have received two injections for primary vaccination between 21-92 days apart (can attend)

*Booster injections - first booster no less than 150, no more than 215 days after above (5 - 7months)

**Further booster injections no more than one year apart.

Any horse/ pony not complying should not be unloaded

Unfortunately, without the above you will be unable to participate in the competition.

Whilst at the WLSJ and other competitions please do not let your horses make contact/socialise with other horses and please keep to box parks and don't mix with onsite livery horses.

We hope this will not affect many people but will also encourage those who have vaccinated that we are taking this threat to your pony's well-being seriously.
