

CLOTHING

It is Pony Club Policy that members must always be turned out in a smart, clean, safe way. The basics are the same for most events/occasions, but there are some events that require specific clothes.

BASIC CLOTHING

- 1) Regulation hat (see attached hat tagging note) plain in dark navy or black.
- 2) Hairnet
- 3) Shirt (white) and tie/Polo shirt
- 4) Rugby/Sweat shirt
- 5) Pony Club badge [and efficiency test felt]
- 6) Gloves
- 7) Light jodhpurs (beige, cream or white permitted)
- 8) Standard riding/jodhpur boots (with a well-defined cut heel)
- 9) NO jewellery
- 10) NO spurs (only permitted if rider has had form completed and approved)

SPECIFIC CLOTHING - as above plus:

- 1) Visiting instructor - always shirt and tie
- 2) Racing - crash hat no peak, silks, body protector, medical armband
- 3) Cross Country - crash hat no peak, long sleeves, body protector and, where you have a medical condition, a medical armband
- 4) Mounted Games - crash hat no peak, long sleeves, no badge
- 5) Dismounted/quiz/fun – jeans/dark jodhpurs, PC sweat/rugby shirt, safe footwear, no hat
- 6) All competitions - shirt, tie, riding jacket
- 7) Tri/Tetathlon – jeans and PC sweat/rugby shirt for shooting, appropriate for swimming and running. Riding as per cross country
- 8) Hunting - tie can be replaced by pony club stock

AIR JACKET - If you wish to wear an air jacket it must be worn on top of AND AS WELL AS a normal body protector
