As a BHSII / Senior Coach and a BDCC Level 2 recognised dressage coach, Julia Cory brings a wealth of experience and passion to her equestrian teaching. Julia's journey with horses began at a young age where she actively participated in all Pony Club activities, particularly dressage and show jumping. Her enthusiasm was sparked for coaching whilst working at a small riding school in Berkshire teaching children and adults from beginner level to more experienced riders. To refine her skills, Julia underwent comprehensive training through the BHS Pathway. Her expertise grew further while working at Kate Hamilton's equestrian centre in Windsor Great Park, where she not only coached dressage but also had the opportunity to train young horses and ride them up to advanced levels.
