The above are the competition dates for the different disciplines.

Area show jumping and eventing start at 70cm and go up to 110cm. The 70cm and 80cm classes are grassroots level and if you were successful you could qualify for the Regional Championships at Rectory Farm. The 90cm and above classes qualify you for the main Championships at Offchurch Bury.

At area dressage, if you compete in the 70 or 80 tests you would qualify for Rectory, with the higher tests qualifying you for the main champs.

Successful teams at Area Horse & Pony Care qualify for the main champs, with successful teams at Area Quiz having separate champs held in Sheffield.

If you are a successful junior or above at Area tet, you would qualify for the main championships. Strong tadpoles and minis would be aiming for the June mini international competition.

For mounted games, if you are successful at the area competition you go forward to the central zones in July.

When competing at Areas you need to speak to the discipline managers in advance so they are aware of your intensions to compete. They can then add you to training lists. In previous years we have been able to send multiple teams to compete at the various heights but if you wish to be selected for teams we will be having criteria for members to meet.

- We would like to see members at training sessions on the ponies/horses they wish to compete leading up to competitions
- They must be active members of the branch, whether volunteering at events or attending rallies, training etc.
- If you go to areas and are successful we do expect you to go onto champs or make us aware that you are unable to make the August champ dates.
- You must have a proven track record at the height you wish to compete at at Areas.

What we expect of you as a team member

- Attend training sessions leading up to the competition.
- You have made yourself aware of the rules for each discipline.
- Tack and clothing comply with rules and you have PC branch clothing
- Course walk with your team and the trainer
- Attend prize giving

### Area 9 Rule re Eligibility to Represent the Branch at Area Competitions

In order to be eligible to compete at Area Competitions, members from all branches in Area 9 and their horse/pony must have actively taken part together in at least 3 rallies, qualifying coaching or training sessions during the previous 12-month period unless prevented from doing so by illness, absence from home, or any other reason which in the opinion of the DC and Area Rep justifies absence.

For the purposes of this rule a rally, qualifying coaching or training session is one which is organised by a branch committee, the Area Rep, or by the training committee and must be a minimum of 1 hour in length. Camp shall be counted as a separate rally, qualifying coaching, or training session.

In addition to demonstrating loyalty to the branch, the combination of horse and rider may also be required to prove their competence, safety, plus fitness of horse or pony, in the specific sport and level that the member wishes to participate at.
