Hosted by the Beaufort Pony Club members travel from all over the British Isles with a large contingency coming from Ireland.

Tetrathlon really know how to put on a great weekend, not only with the four phases of the competition but also the party on the Saturday night!

We had five members competing, Isabel, Lily and Bethany in the minimus girls class and Lexi and Molly competing in the first year junior class.

Saturday the shoot and the swim were held. All got off to strong starts in the classes, with great scores in both sections. Sunday was the turn of the run and the xc. At this event to xc is always a very strong course but there are lots of L fences to help encourage. The juniors went xc first and then ran with both Lexi and Molly having great rounds. In the minimus class they ran first and then tackled the xc. Isabel stormed round to gain a maximum of 1400 points.

Bethany and Lily were part of a Central England team and were 18th, with Isabel as part of another Central England team being 12th. Molly was individual 8th and Lexi individual 11th in the Junior girls.

After his amazing trip to Badminton Tom Woodward was competing at the Defender Branham Horse Trials were he won the National U25 class.

In dressage, member Hannah De Wit has been trying to achieve her goal of scoring over 68% at an FEI International competition. This she achieved at Vale View where, not only did she achieve her goal but also was overall Champion on day 1 and 2nd on day 2 – the only rider to podium on both days.
