

Dressage

Our sole representative at champs in the dressage was Hattie S. She was competing in the intermediate and open classes. In the intermediate Hattie was 12th in her section and in the open she was 11th. In the open class Hattie was part of the Area 9 team which was placed 3rd.







Show Jumping

Competing in the 90cm team class we has Sophie C, Alice R, Isabelle T and Seren W. In the first round So-

phie and Seren jumped clear with Alice and Isabelle just having 4 faults each. In the second round, they all jumped great rounds but a clear round eluded them. In the 100cm we were represented by Georgie A. In her first round she had an unlucky 4 faults and 8 faults in the second.

Eventing

Held at the end of the Championships, over two days, we had an individual in the 90cm and a team plus an individual in the 100cm. Georgie S was our solo representative in the 90cm. She produced a brilliant dressage test of 26.8 to hold a top 3 placing going into the show jumping. Just 4 jumping faults for an unlucky pole and 2 time faults saw them slip a few places but a brilliant clear round a tough track inside the time saw them take 2nd place in their section.



In the 100cm we had Georgie A, Lucy W, Cressie F and Henny P making up our team with Lucy W competing as an individual on her second horse.

They all produced great tests leaving them in good positions in their sections. In the show jumping Cressie was the only one on the team to have a clear but Lucy

W did go clear with her individual ride. The cross country asked many questions with a few drop fences and some tricky lines. Cressie and Lucy (on both her rides) stormed round coming home clear inside the time (Lucy just 0.2 time faults for one round) with Henny and Georgie picking up some faults but still completing.

<u>Section A</u> Lucy was 5th, <u>Section B</u> Cressie 4th, Lucy 5th, <u>Section C</u> Georgie 29th and <u>Section D</u> Henny 17th with the team being placed 10th.




Show Jumping
