ALL riders must wear pony club approved headwear at all times when mounted and back protectors are recommended.

Strictly no cantering or galloping outside of rings.

The committee reserve the right to make changes to the timings of each ring.

ALL horses/ponies to have up to date flu vaccination. Passports must be made available as spot checks will take place.
