AREA 3 MOUNTED GAMES FRIENDLY COMPETITION JUNIOR, NOVICE/ASSISTED AND SENIORS SUNDAY MARCH 15th 2026 SLEDMERE YO25

We are looking forward to holding our friendly competition again with the aim of giving less experienced children a chance to learn the games and branch teams experience prior to Area competitions.

- Games will mainly be those on the Area games 2026 list but there may be some exceptions for the Novice/Assisted. These will be confirmed along with the timetable for the day 1 week prior to the competition. Places will be limited to 1 heat of up to 7 teams. Each game will be run twice to aid training.
- Each team will need to provide a line steward and 1-2 people to help with equipment.
- To be run in accordance with The Pony Club Mounted Games Rules 2026. It is envisaged that the Novice/Assisted competition will be for younger riders but older children may be able to ride in Novice/Assisted teams if genuine beginners. Ponies may be led, but only for safety reasons.
PLEASE NOTE-riders over the age for Seniors (aged 11-18 on 1st January 2026) will be able to compete as part of a team in the Senior competition. However, the trophy will be awarded to the highest placed team made up of children eligible for Senior competition under the Pony Club Mounted Games Rules 2026.
- Refreshments will be available on the day. CASH ONLY.
