Competitors will have the opportunity to do a Training Round at the 'new height' before the start of each class – the fee for this is included in the entry fee and times will be allocated accordingly

All Double Clears will qualify for A9 Show Championships in September 2022

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

CLASS ONE: 40cm Lead Rein only.

The course will be single phase with four upright fences in each section (total of 8 jumps) with the whole course set at 40cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

CLASS TWO: 50cm May be assisted*

The course will be single phase with five upright, single fences in each section (total of 10 jumps) with the whole course set at 50cm; the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course. * Any contact between the assistant and rider/horse will render the combination HC.

CLASS THREE: 60cm

The course will be single phase with six fences in each section (total of 12 fences) with the whole course set at 60cm - there may be spread fences, the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

CLASS FOUR: 70cm

The course will be single phase with six fences in the first section and six in the second (total of 12 fences) with the whole course set at 70cm - there will be a double and there will be spread fences, the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

CLASS FIVE: 80cm

The course will be single phase with six fences in the first section and six in the second (total of 12 fences) with the whole course set at 80cm - there will be a double and there will be spread fences, the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

CLASS Six: 90cm

The course will be single phase with six fences in the first section and six in the second (total of 12 fences) with the whole course set at 90cm - there will be a double and there will be spread fences, the second section will be timed and used to decide placings. Faults accumulative over the whole course.

Entry Fee: £15 per combination

All entries to be made via Horse-Events.co.uk
(a booking fee will be added to the entry fee)

Rosettes: 1st – 6th in each Class & Clear Round Rosettes

Closing date for entries: Tuesday 5th October 2021

Entries will be limited, and classes may be closed before the closing date.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

Your entry is deemed to include acceptance of these rules

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Show Jumping Pony Club Rules 2021.
2. The Judge's decision is final.
3. Protests and Objections - please see Pony Club Show Jumping Rule book 2021
4. All hats must have the current (aquamarine) Pony Club tag.
5. Turnout for ALL riders and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show Jumping 2021
6. Horses/ponies competing may only be ridden by their competitor, at the venue.
7. Spurs may be worn in accordance with the Show jumping Rules 2021
8. No horse/pony under the age of 4 may compete in the Show Jumping.

Competitors must print their own numbers which may be used in a number bib or attached to the saddlecloth; numbers should be printed as large as possible.

Entries

1. All entries to be made via Horse Events
2. In the event of cancellation, £2 of the entry fee will be retained to defray costs. Refunds will be done online via Horse Events
3. There will be a booking fee for each entry.
4. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you are agreeing to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed please tell the photographer on entering the arena before you jump.
5. **No unauthorised photographers allowed – please check with the secretary on the day.**

Rider and Public Safety

1. When not competing all horses/ponies must be kept to the horse box park or collecting rings. They must not be exercised in the car/lorry park, or among spectators.
2. Horses/ponies tied to trailers or lorries must not be left unattended.
3. **All dogs MUST be kept on a short lead at all times. The owners of any loose dogs will be fined £20 per dog per incident with proceeds donated to the Air Ambulance. Please clean up after your dog.**

Event Liability

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers, or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, cars, their contents and accessories, or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.

Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organisers and all officials and stewards.

COVID-19

1. Please do not attend if you are feeling unwell or have any Covid symptoms
2. Social distancing is always to be practiced.
3. Parking - there must be a gap of at least 10m between all horseboxes and trailers
4. Parents and assistants will not be allowed to access the warm-up arena, there will be a steward to adjust the fences.
5. Competitors in Classes 1 & 2 may have an assistant with them in the warm-up arena
6. For classes 3 - 6 time in the 'warm up' arena will be limited to 20 minutes with a maximum 5 horses at one time.
e.g. Allocated time – 10.00 Warm Up Arena with Jumps – 09.40
7. We request that competitors adhere to the above rules and allocated times
