Please arrive from 9.30am with the children ready to ride at 10am. The timetable for the day will be available on arrival, but will involve a mixture of ridden and dismounted activities.

Please bring a picnic and plenty of hay and water for ponies.

For those who have not been before the postcode is SO40 2PG. **The satnav may not take you the right way so please ignore it if it tries to take you OVER the motorway over a single track bridge.** The correct route is to come to the crossroads in Copythorne and take the road signposted to Newbridge. Immediately after going UNDER the M27 take the track on the RIGHT, over a cattle grid and continue up the track for  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile (Ignoring Coppitts Cottage on the right at the start of the track) until you see a white cottage with a tall chimney and a silver horsebox. Continue past keeping the house on the left until you see big double field gates on the left. Turn into the field and park in the first field where there is plenty of room to turn round and park.

Please pick up all droppings but don't worry about loose hay, my ponies are happy to Hoover that up!
