Turnout - Children should be wearing, shirt, PC tie, PC jumper or jacket, PC badge and current felt, plain dark hat silk, plain jodhpurs, gloves and clean boots. Body protectors can be worn if preferred.

Jackets can be removed for the stable management (PC jumpers / coats can be worn if required).

Turnout - Ponies should be clean, trimmed and tidy, well-groomed with clean, safe tack & a plain numnah.

Ponies will be put in the stables when not being ridden.

The following equipment will be needed for your pony

- ✓ Water bucket
- ✓ Haynet
- ✓ A head collar
- ✓ Grooming kit
- ✓ Clean / safe Tack
- ✓ Poo picker / bucket (to keep stable / parking area clean)
