Schedule of Classes

Class 1 – PC 70 Grassroots Regional Qualifier Show Jumping Team and Individual Competition

This class is open to teams of four members from Area 7 Branches and Centres aged 13 years and under as at the 1st January 2024.

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1st round will be 70cm and the 2nd round 75cm. There will be a scheduled course walk for later teams if there are more than 12 teams.

Team and Individual Jumping rosettes to 8th place. Turnout rosettes to 3rd place.

All Branches/Centres are asked to enter a maximum of <u>3</u> teams only.

Entry Fee - £24 per competitor

Class 2 – PC 70+ Grassroots Regional Qualifier Show Jumping Individual Only Competition

This class is open to Individuals from Area 7 Branches and Centres aged 14years and over as at the 1st January 2024.

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1st round will be 70cm and the 2nd round 75cm. Competitors will jump after class 1 teams.

Individual Jumping rosettes to 8th place.

Entry Fee - £24 per competitor

Class 3 - PC 80 Grassroots Regional Qualifier Show Jumping Team and Individual Competition

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1st round and 2nd round will be 80cm. There will be a scheduled course walk for later teams if there are more than 12 teams. Team and Individual Jumping rosettes to 8th place. Turnout rosettes to 3rd place. All Branches/Centres are asked to enter a maximum of <u>3</u> teams only. <u>Entry Fee</u> - £24 per competitor

Class 4 – PC90 National Qualifier Show Jumping Team and Individual Competition

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1st round is 90cm and 2nd round 95cm. There will be a scheduled course walk for later teams if there are more than 12 teams. Team and Individual Jumping rosettes to 8th place. Turnout rosettes to 3rd place. All Branches/Centres are asked to enter a maximum of <u>3</u> teams only. <u>Entry Fee</u> - £24 per competitor

Class 5 – PC 100 National Qualifier Show Jumping Team and Individual Competition

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1st round is 1m and 2nd round 1.05m. There will only be one course walk at the beginning of the class. Team and Individual Jumping rosettes to 8th place. Turnout rosettes to 3rd place. <u>Entry Fee</u> - £24 per competitor

Class 6 – PC110 National Qualifier Show Jumping Team and Individual Competition

There will be 2 rounds followed by a jump off. The 1^{st} round is 1.10m and 2^{nd} round 1.15m. There will only be one course walk at the beginning of the class. Team and Individual Jumping rosettes to 6^{th} place. Turnout rosettes to 3rd place. <u>Entry Fee</u> - £24 per competitor

Vaccinations

Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Rules 2024. DC's/Centre Proprietor will be required to vouch that all their branch competitors meet the requirement. A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.

We ask that all PC110, PC100, PC90 PC80 and PC70 Area Teams ensure they present themselves to the Turnout Judges 30mins before the jump time of the first competitor. These will be given to you with your team times.

Entries – Form A to be in by <u>1st June</u>. A link to entry form A will be sent to the Branch DC to be completed online using Microsoft Forms. Online entries <u>https://wwpc.entrymaster.online/</u> will be opened on **1st June**. Online Entries will close on <u>17th June</u>. Entries can only be from those who have been selected by their branch and notified by their DC/Centre Proprietor/Show Jumping Manager.

Withdrawals and refunds - Full refunds of entry fee will be given up until the closing date of the competition. After the closing date no refunds will be made except on the production of a vet or medical certificate. In the event of abandonment 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Times – Times will be available on the West Warwickshire Pony Club website after 7pm on Tuesday 25th June.
