#### APPLICABLE TO OPEN, INTERMEDIATE, NOVICE AND REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Horses/ponies can be ridden in three tests in one day, with up to two riders. Combination of Horse and Rider can compete at two adjacent levels of the same Sport at the Area Competition or at the Championships, i.e., combinations can compete at Preliminary PC70 and Grassroots PC80, Grassroots PC80 and Novice, Novice and Intermediate or Intermediate and Open. Should a combination qualify at two levels, a further place should be passed down at the lower level.

#### **Vaccinations**

Vaccinations must be in accordance with the Pony Club Rules 2025. DC's/Centre Proprietor will be required to vouch that all their branch competitors meet the requirement. A valid passport and vaccination record must accompany the horse/pony to this event and must be available for inspection if required by event officials.

**Entries** – Form A to be in by **26**<sup>th</sup> **May**. A link to entry form A will be sent to the Branch DC to be completed online using Microsoft Forms. Online entries <a href="https://wwpc.entrymaster.online/">https://wwpc.entrymaster.online/</a> will be opened on **26**<sup>th</sup> **May**. Online Entries will close on **13**<sup>th</sup> **June**. Entries can only be made by those who have been selected by their branch and notified by their DC/Centre Proprietor/Dressage Manager.

**Withdrawals and refunds** - Full refunds of entry fee will be given up until the closing date of the competition. After the closing date no refunds will be made except on the production of a vet or medical certificate. In the event of abandonment 50% of the entry fee will be refunded.

Times – Times will be available on the West Warwickshire Pony Club website after **7pm on Tuesday 17**<sup>th</sup> **June.**

**Rules** – Please check 2025 book for all current rules and eligibility. All members of your area teams should always adhere to these rules.
