Schedule of Classes

Class One: 80cm Class Two: 90cm

Both classes are for teams of three combinations only- all scores to count. Teams must have three different riders and horses/ponies can only jump once in a class.

Both classes will be run single phase. Distances will be as for horses as per the Pony Club Showjumping Rules.

There is a limit of 15 teams per class; each Branch/Centre may only enter one team in one of the classes initially – if there are still spaces a week before the closing date, then Branches/Centres may then enter another team in a class with spaces available.

The competition will be run under The Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2025

Closing Date: Friday 30th May 2025 (will close early if full) Entry Fee: £60 per team.

Ten entry passes per team will be allocated: the passes will be sent to the Team Manager named on the Entry Form.

Rosettes to sixth place, with sashes awarded to the winning team in each class.

Presentation in the arena: 1st – 3rd teams to be mounted.

4th – 6th rosettes to be collected ringside/from the judges' box. All riders at presentation must be correctly turned out as per Pony Club Show jumping Rules 2025.

As a courtesy to Royal Three Counties Show, riders should wear white or beige jodphurs/breeches whilst competing and for the presentation of rosettes; dark coloured contrast seats are permitted

The Entry Form must be completed and returned to **Ellie Hunt by Friday 30th May 2025** – entry is secured by full payment via the link to Showing Scene, which will be sent to the DC/CP/Team Manager on receipt of the Entry Form. A waiting list will be held if necessary. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt of the Entry Form and payment being made via Showing Scene. Only DCs/Branch Proprietors/Team Managers make the entry for their team.

The Declaration Form must be completed and emailed to **Jane Ogle by Friday 6th June 2025** (changes/ substitutions will be accepted before 12 noon Friday 13th June and must be emailed to Jane asap). Please email the Commentator's notes with the Declaration Form.

Times will be available on ponyclubresults.co.uk on **Friday 13th June 2025** (not before 18:00).

Rules & Regulations

PASSPORTS: horses/ponies will not be allowed to compete without their passport with valid flu vaccinations – DCs/Centre Proprietors will be asked to confirm that your horse's/pony's flu vaccination record is correct and up to date. **Passports will be spot** checked for compliance. A horse with a non-compliant passport will NOT be allowed to compete (nor will any horse/pony it has travelled to the venue with on the day) and there will be no refund of entry. Please allow time for passport checking. Please check the Pony Club website for current rules: See Resources on The Pony Club website.

NUMBERS: rider numbers MUST be printed out by each competitor – if wearing a number bib please wear front and back. If the number is to be put on the saddlecloth – please do A5 size and wear both sides. If the number is to be worn on the back of the rider, then please print at least A5 size. Numbers to be printed/written as large as possible in dark ink please.

Bridle numbers are NOT to be used anywhere!! Competitors' numbers must be visible when mounted, at all times whilst on the Showground.

1. Stallions are allowed with prior permission from the Organiser (Jane Ogle); any stallion ridden by a Pony Club member **must** have written permission from their DC/Centre Proprietor which must be sent to Jane Ogle, with the Declaration Form. Stallions must wear stallion discs and ribbons and be led with a chain lead rope.

All horse/ponies must be at least 5 years old on the day of the competition. Turnout for ALL Pony Club members and horses should be as in the Pony Club Rules for Show-jumping 2025.

SPURS & PADDED BATONS: ALL spurs worn anywhere on the showground must comply with Pony Club rules. Only those competitors with a yellow hat tag are allowed to wear spurs. Only padded batons as specified in the PC Rules 2025 may be used anywhere on the showground. Misuse of spurs/padded batons by any competitor will be recorded and reported and may result in disqualification (for the team) from the competition.
 Any abuse of horses/ponies, officials, other competitors, or members of the public will not be tolerated and those found doing so will be asked to leave the venue with no compensation and may be reported to the relevant authority.







4. Judges' decision is final. Any objection must be handed to the Judges' Box in writing with a ± 50 deposit (which will be forfeited if the objection is not upheld) within 15 minutes of the incident and BEFORE the end of that class.

5. **INSURANCE:** please ensure that you have adequate/appropriate insurance for riders, horse, property and third party.

6. PHOTOGRAPHS: by entering this competition you agree to be photographed whilst competing; these photographs may be used for future publicity. If you do not wish to be photographed, please tell the photographer on entering the arena before you jump.
7. Participants attend at their own risk; neither the Organisers or Royal Three Counties Show will be liable for any loss, damage or accident to horses, riders, property, or other persons.

8. **REFUNDS & WITHDRAWALS:** If a team needs to withdraw before the closing date, a refund will only be given if their place can be filled from the Wait List. There will be no refunds after the closing date. All refunds will be subject to a £5 admin fee.

Disclaimers

1. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the Organisers of this event or The Pony Club nor any agent, employee, or representative of these bodies, nor the landlord or his tenant, accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land , cars/ lorries/trailers, their contents and accessories or any other personal property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.

Entries are only accepted on this basis.

2. The Organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all officials and stewards.
