There is the option to do a ride only phase. Entry fee £35 for 70cm -1m (class 23a), and £15 for 30-60cm class (23b). Please make a note of the height you would like to jump on the entry form.

Competition to be run under Pony Club Tetrathlon Rules 2026. All competitors to be members of Pony Club. Maximum class ages as at 1st January 2026. For classes with pistol shooting rather than beanbags, competitors must be 8 years or older on 18th July.

Classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 7 & 8 are Qualifying classes for individuals in Area 5, Area 7 & Area 18 for the Tetrathlon Championships being held at Offchurch Bury 14-16th August. Qualification for individuals as per the tetrathlon rule book. Qualifying teams declared for championships as per the tetrathlon rule book.

There will also be a team competition with teams of any mix of boys/girls for each age category/xc height and we will put individuals not in a branch team into a mixed team where possible. There will be individual and team rosettes to 6th place in all classes and special rosettes for all unplaced competitors in classes 11-22. **We are very grateful to AC Jackson, Equine Products, Rowen Barbary, Stables Saddlery, Severn Edge Vets and Henry James Saddlery for sponsoring goody bags for the winners of each tetrathlon class.**

Triathlon and tetrathlon prizegivings will take place throughout the day as each class finishes once the 30 minute period for objections and queries has passed. The decision of the organisers and judges is final. Queries should be made by the DC or Team Manager of the relevant competitor.



Tetrathlon courses will be challenging for the older classes and inviting for the younger classes and all classes will include plenty of L options. Each age group has a novice class which will run over the lower height course, and have the L fences for that course. If any tiddlers would like to jump up a height and do the 50-60cm class, please make a note on the entry form. Tadpoles who want to jump the 70cm course will need to enter the mini novice class.

The main (70cm+) cross country course will be open for walking from 2pm on Saturday 18th July. The mini (30-60cm) cross country course will be open for walking from 8.30am on Sunday 19th July.

Martha Lily Photography will be in attendance for both the main and mini xc course on Sunday. Light refreshments will be available on Saturday at Wrekin. Thistle Catering and Pickering's Ices will be in attendance on Sunday. A&M Saddlery will be at Berriewood on Sunday for all your equipment needs. Tom Hollinshead Farrier and Severn Edge Vets will be in attendance, but if you require their services on the day, please arrange payment directly with them.

Camping and Stabling is available at Berriewood Farm. Please contact them directly to arrange 01743 718252

Please ensure you arrive at the shoot hall 20 minutes before your time to allow for gun checks. Guns may only be unboxed when the RCO gives the order to unbox them at the start of the detail. No one under the age of 18 can carry a pistol unless accompanied by someone over 21 years. Protective eyewear must be worn for those shooting at 7m. Safety flags must be used when the gun is unboxed.

Dive certificates must be uploaded onto Pelham. Only one parent/coach will be allowed at the end of the pool. Classes 21 and 22 will swim widths. For classes 1-20, any child unable to swim one length within the time allowed MUST request an outside lane and for classes 19 & 20 MUST use a buoyancy aid. Please do not select outside lane if your child can swim more than 2 lengths without buoyancy aids unless they are very nervous swimmers to ensure outside lanes are available for those who really need them

No dogs at Wrekin College or on the XC course at Berriewood, and no muddy shoes in the sports hall at Wrekin College.

Horses must be vaccinated in accordance with pony club rules and passports must be available for spot checks. Spurs may only be worn if the rider has the Pony Club yellow spurs hat tag.

Classes 11 onwards will not be timed. Mini competitors who have 3 refusals may miss out that fence and continue on the course provided the fence judge and stewards consider them safe to do so. They must then make way for faster competitors. Tadpoles, Beanies and Tiddlers may also continue after having had 3 refusals at a fence, and all may be assisted to remount following the slip rail. Beanies and Tadpole Novice competitors may be assisted, Tiddlers may be led.

Run numbers will be provided but please print your ride phase competitor numbers from Pony Club Results so they are clearly visible to fence judges



Any competitor requiring reasonable adjustment dispensation must have let the organisers know and applied through the approved Pony Club procedure at least 2 weeks before the event.

Full refunds will be given up until the closing of the competition. After the closing date no refunds without a Doctor's or Vet's certificate, to be provided at the time of withdrawal.
