- ⊙ **Competitors MUST be on lead rein**
- ⊙⊙ **Competitors may be assisted verbally or someone can run in front of the child but neither the Pony nor the Child may be touched. If they are they will be classed as H/C.**
- ⊙⊙⊙ **Competitors cannot be assisted in any way including verbal assistance. If competitors receive assistance, they will be classed as H/C or transferred to Class 2a.**

In a “single phase” class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock.

Rules

Horses and Ponies may only compete once in a class and in a **maximum of 3 classes**.

Course Walk for Class 1, 8.30am for 9.00am for a **PROMPT START**.

In a single phase class faults are accumulated in both sections with all riders going through to the timed part of the course against the clock.

Entry Fee: £16 per competitor per class. There is a one-off booking fee. Online entries only – via [Entrymaster - Event Entry \(Pony Clubs\)](#). Strictly NO entries after the closing date of Wednesday 21st October.

This competition is for teams of 3 or 4, the second phase will be timed. Individuals may enter and will be put into teams if possible. If Branches do not notify the secretary of team details by Wednesday 21st October, we will put your members into teams for you. The best 3 scores will count. Team members will also be judged as individuals. Rosettes will be awarded to Teams and Individuals 1st to 6th place.

This competition is run under Pony Club Rules 2026. Hard Hats tagged in accordance with Pony Club Rules 2026 to be worn at all times when mounted. Jackets and ties or stocks must be worn and hair should either be above the collar or securely tied back and contained in a hair net. Only baton style whips are permitted.

There will be a tack check before competitors will be allowed to compete but it is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that all stitching etc is safe.

There will be an unmounted prize giving at the end of each class.

The number of horses in the collecting ring will be limited for safety reasons.

Any objections must be lodged with £20.00 within 15 minutes of the occurrence, this will only be allowed if the objection is upheld. The judges' decision will be final.

No bicycles to be ridden around the showground. **NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED.**

There will be refreshments available.
