<b>JEWELLERY</b>	<b>NO JEWELLERY SHOULD BE WORN.</b> All earrings must be removed.		
<b>CLOTHING</b>	NWPC Navy Polo Shirt or white shirt and Pony Club tie	As for mounted	Or NWPC XC skin
	NWPC Navy sweatshirt (not hoody)	As for mounted	Body Protector BETA 2009 and later
	NWPC Navy coat or plain navy or black coat with no hood	As for mounted
